“But Christ is faithful as the Son over God’s house. And we are his house, if indeed we hold firmly to our confidence and the hope in which we glory.” (3:5,6)

4. The _____ Of Christ (4:9)

“Therefore, remains then, a Sabbath-rest for the people of God, for anyone who enters God’s rest also rest from their works, just as God did from his.” (4:9)

5. The _____ Of Christ (5:8)

“Son, though he was, he learned obedience from what he suffered and, once made perfect, he became the source of eternal salvation for all who obey him...” (5:8)

“We have this hope as an anchor for the soul, firm and secure. It enters the inner sanctuary behind the curtain, where our forerunner, Jesus, has entered on our behalf.” (6:19)
