2. 1 John reminds us of some of the most beloved NT verses:

*“We love Him because He first loved us...” (1 John 3:1)*

*“If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us of our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteous.” (1 John 1:9)*

*“Beloved, let us love one another. For love is of God and everyone that loves is born of God and knows God.” (1 John 4:7,8)*

3. Why was it important that John begin with the personhood of Jesus and His eyewitness experience of Christ's appearance? What lies were false teachers stating?
4. Gnosticism (a false teaching at that time) believed that material things were evil but spiritual things were good. Why would this separation be false? How does our material world/bodies make a difference in our spiritual lives?
5. 1 John 4:10 says, “This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins.” What does it mean to you that God loved you first? Do you believe His love is unconditional?
