- 1. What struck you as most meaningful in this video?
- 2. Steve says, "A father is the most important man in his daughter's life." How does this truth affect the way you will raise your daughter? (If you don't have a daughter, how can you apply these questions to younger girls/women in your life—how can you model influence to them as a Christian man?)

- 5. What role do you play in helping your daughter find and marry the right man?
- 6. What are some of the biggest lies of modern-day feminism? (pp. 205-206) and how can you teach your daughter the incalculable value of motherhood and shaping a home?
- 7. Just as for boys, the three "A's" your daughters need are; Attention, Affirmation, & Affection. How do these prevent love hunger? Protect against gender confusion? Help her to look forward to becoming a woman?
