Oh, I will sing of the goodness of God.

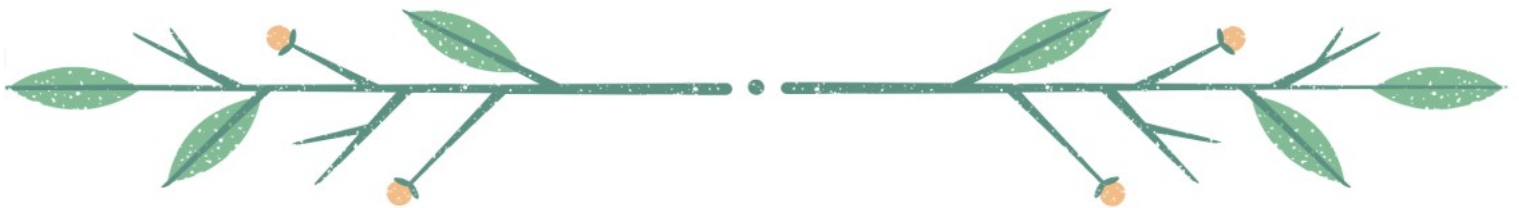
I love Your voice, You have led me through the fire.


