Where to start

Welcome to a special day. The schedule and routine may be off today, but that doesn't mean our intention and desire has to be. While it may be cold and snowy outside, we think this moment allows for family interaction around Jesus' Sermon on the Mount.

As you are aware, we are spending the school year on the mount with Jesus in Matthew 5,6,7. And as we take time through the year hearing these words, we can also take time to interact with them. And, with this special snow day, we can interact as a family or with a friend group.

So, especially if you have kiddos, have everyone grab their Bibles, put the devices away and bring everyone together at the table or in the living room. Signal this is intentional and purposeful.

Start by listening to Jesus' Sermon on the Mount. You can follow the link below for Travis' most recent recitation of the sermon. Let it play and don't stop. Sit and listen to Jesus together.

Communion

Jesus spent the Sermon on the Mount teaching us how to live the life of the Kingdom — a life shaped by humility, mercy, reconciliation and love. He showed us what wholeness looks like when a heart is fully turned toward the Father.

At the Last Supper, Jesus did something important. He didn't give another sermon. He gave himself.

The bread reminds us that the One who taught us to hunger and thirst for righteousness allowed his body to be broken.

The cup reminds us that the One who taught us mercy and forgiveness poured out his life so we could be made whole.

When we take communion, we are not just remembering Jesus' death. We are proclaiming that his life, his teaching, his cross and his resurrection still define us. The Kingdom he described on the mountain was secured at the table and fulfilled at the empty tomb.

So as we eat and drink today, we remember and we proclaim that Jesus is Lord, his Kingdom has come and we are learning to live his life because he first gave his life for us.

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Communion

A NOTE FOR PARENTS

Communion is one of the simplest and most meaningful practices we share as followers of Jesus. On this snow day, taking communion at home is a beautiful opportunity to slow down and help your children understand why we do this together.

The bread and the cup help us remember Jesus. His life, his love, his death and his resurrection. Communion isn't about getting everything right or having all the answers. It's about remembering and proclaiming that Jesus gave himself for us and invites us to live his way.

As you share this moment, let your children ask questions. Tell them the story in simple words. Help them see that this is a family practice. A way we return again and again to Jesus' table, reminding ourselves who he is and who we are becoming.

If you're comfortable, let them participate with your guidance. And give them some responsibility in the communion time- prayer or thought or reading of scripture.

There's no rush. No pressure. Just space to remember, to give thanks and to grow together. A moment at the table together is a moment to teach, share and commune as a family/group.

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Singing

You may want to take time to sing. We know that can be difficult in smaller settings- especially spaces we're not accustomed to singing together.

Below is a YouTube playlist link to multiple Praise and Harmony worship songs. Browse through those and sing together with the help of the video. It's a simple solution to bringing every voice together in a moment of worship.

You can write each person's verse below. Then at the end of the day or at dinner time tonight, ask everyone to share their memory verse- by memory!

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
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Words of Jesus
