## MS/HS Supply List $\left(6^{\text {th }}-\right.$ I $^{\text {th }}$ Grade)

The following items are for personal use and should be stored in the student's locker or backpack for daily use. Any extra items should be stored at home in order to replenish supplies as needed (Typically around January)

- Each student will have 7 classes - they need 7 individual binders with notebook paper or I large binder with 7 dividers and notebook paper - this is a personal preference
- Each student will need a composition notebook for all core classes ( 5 total)
- Mechanical pencils -- sometimes a sharpener is not available
- Highlighters - color does not matter
- pens - red and blue/black
- notebook paper
- folders - at least 5
- Students in grades 6-8 need a calculator for math - a simple scientific calculator will work -these run \$ı-\$20 and will make the child's life much easier
- Students in Algebra a also need a simple calculator
- HS students in Algebra 2 may need a graphing calculator - please wait for the teacher's instructions before purchasing one of these -- they are typically $\$ 80-\$ 100$.
- Graph Paper
- Colored pencils
- Bible
-- Planner -- These will be furnished by BCS for students in grades 6-8 -- HS students will need to furnish their own.
****All notebook paper and composition books should be college ruled
****Please note - teachers may ask for specific supplies appropriate for their class. If you would prefer to wait to purchase supplies until after the first day of school that may be best. Please ensure your child comes to school on the first day with paper and a pencil, at a minimum. (Extra items may include scissors, rulers, compass, protractor, etc)
