**Sermon Title: Humility-Focused**

**Main Idea: Our Lord calls us to live in humility.**

### **Breaking the Ice**

### **Excavating the Truth**

- Reread Luke 14:7–14
- How many times is the word *invite* (the Greek word “call”) used in these verses? How does the word tie verses 14:7–14 together?
- There are verbs in verses 11 and 14 referred to as “divine passives.” What is the significance of these verbs in these verses?

### **Applying the Truth Personally**

- What is one area of my life where I tend to exalt myself? How can this passage help me remain humble?
- How do I operate like the host of verse 12 who only invites his friends, and what must I change to show the generosity that Jesus demands?

### **Applying the Truth Congregationally**

- In what ways might we show personal humility while engaging in collective arrogance as a church?
- What does it mean for us to show humility as a church? Where are we failing and how can this passage help us?

### **Digging Deeper**

- How does Luke 6:32–36 strengthen the idea of Luke 14:12–14?
- Compile a list from Proverbs regarding humility. How does your collection of verses reinforce the point of Luke 14:7–14?
