Breaking the Ice

Excavating the Truth

- Reread Psalm 94
- How is the Psalmist's frustration (1-3) adjusted by the reality of verses 22-23?
- What is the significance of the repeated use of "chasten" and "teach" in verses 10-13?

Applying the Truth Personally

- How can I cry for God's vengeance while obeying the command to love my enemies?
- How does trusting in God's plan help me manage anger and despair over injustice?

Applying the Truth Congregationally

- In today's world of instant communication and social media, how can we help one another rightly respond to the endless stream of injustice we witness?
- How can we create an environment in our church that supports those who are suffering persecution?
- What potential dangers might our church face by overemphasizing the wicked?

Digging Deeper

- Read Psalm 93 and 94 and detail how God's sovereignty impacts God's vengeance.

- Consider these verses; Leviticus 19:17-18, Romans 12:10, Hebrews 12:5-11 with Psalm 94. How do we adjust our reactions in light of God's vengeance.
