Purpose:

- Prepare lessons through the curriculum that are engaging and developmentally appropriate for the students in the ministry (primarily kids aged 0-3 years old - nursery and 3 years old - 4th grade - CG Kids).

- Meet regularly with the East Mesa Leadership team to develop ways to connect with the Cadence Community.
- With the help of others on the leadership team, create and develop a once a month kids experience for families in the community.
- Be present at and assist with "All Hands on Deck" CG | East Mesa events.
- Be present on Sundays to be a warm, welcoming and consistent presence for the kids.
- Lead training huddles once a quarter with CG Kids Teachers and Assistants.
- Be willing to jump in and be flexible to what the Sunday mornings might entail.
- Continually look for people to bring on the team and have ICNU conversations with those people.
- Show Jesus' light to the students and encourage them to love those around them.
- Help to build the foundations of their understanding of the Bible and who Jesus is.
- Other duties as assigned by the supervisor.
