Join us tonight for the Messiah in the Passover program Palm Sunday, March 24,2024 at 5:00PM. Pastor Jeff Kipp will present a 60-90minute program designed to give participants a deeper understanding both of the Jewish Passover and of the Communion table. Using the traditional elements of a Jewish Passover Seder, Pastor Kipp will explain their history, what each element represents, and how the Passover is fulfilled though Jesus' death at Calvary. Please note: this is not a meal, but an explanation of the Seder meal with the elements display on each plate for consumption.
