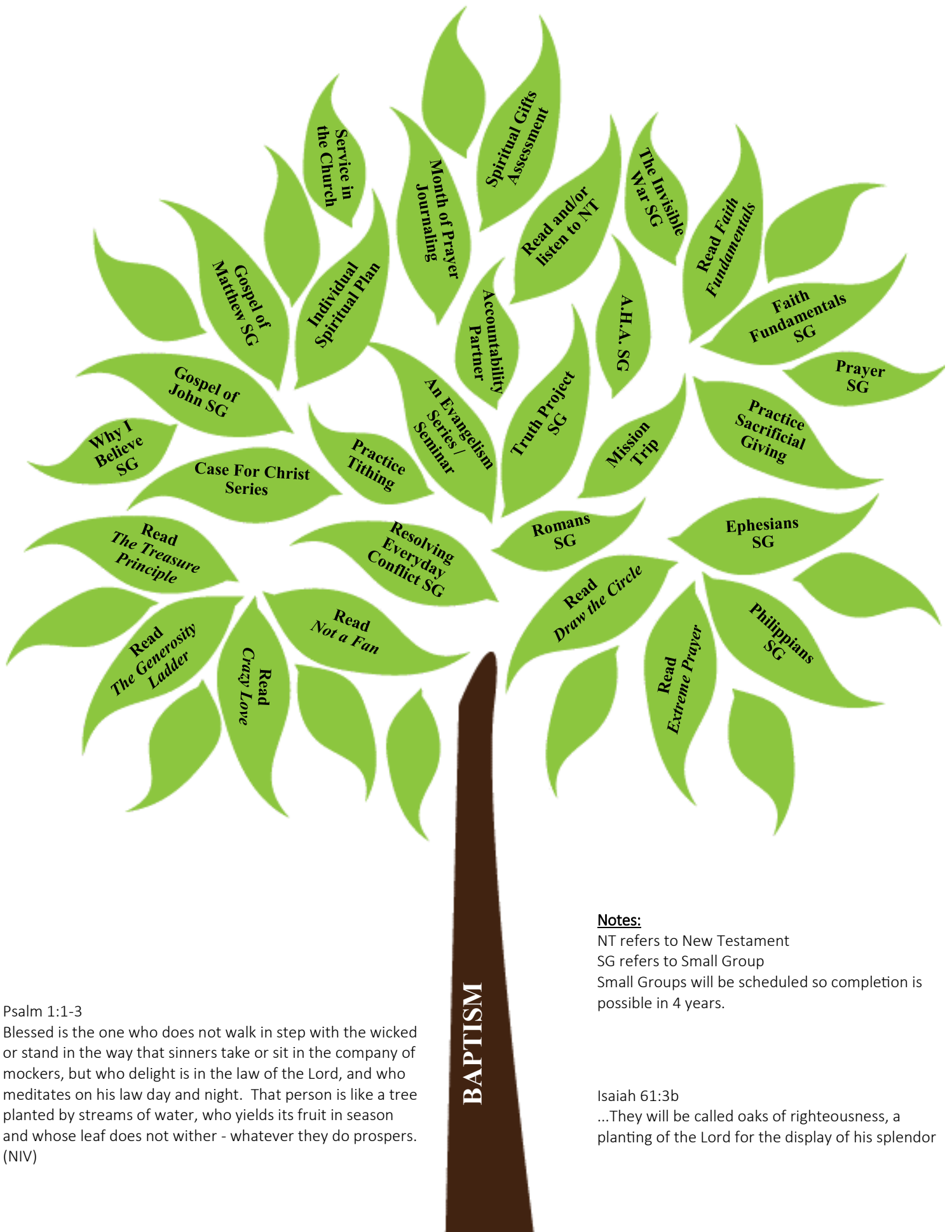


GROWTH JOURNEY
