Succession Plan Starting January 1, 2026

As we enter our senior pastor succession plan following Dr. Tim's retirement on December 31st, we do so prayerfully, trusting God will lead us in unity and wisdom. The Staff Parish Relations Committee (SPRC) wishes to clearly communicate the succession process as dictated by our Book of Discipline:

1. SPRC has named Rev. Butch Blackwell as St. John's Interim Lead Pastor, who has graciously accepted, until a candidate is hired. Rev. Butch will preach church services beginning the first two Sundays in January.
2. SPRC has agreed with Rev. Dr. Jeff Kersey formerly with Mt. Horeb Church (Lexington, SC) to preach the 1st and 4th Sundays of the month until a candidate is hired. Rev. Will and Rev. Butch will split preaching duties the 2nd and 3rd Sundays of the month.
3. Vanderbloemen, the executive search firm hired by SPRC, is currently recruiting and vetting potential senior pastor candidates. The job opening was posted on October 22, 2025. To protect candidates and maintain integrity, some details must remain confidential. We commit, however, to regular updates so you know where we are in the process.
4. As candidates are presented to SPRC and interviews conducted, per St. John's Book of Discipline, SPRC shall present one candidate at a time to the Church Council, where a vote will be taken.
5. Following Church Council vote, the candidate will preach one Sunday service at St. John's, followed by a Question-and-Answer session conducted that same afternoon.
6. A Charge Conference will be required to officially elect a candidate for the Lead Pastor role.

While SPRC expects the search process to take approximately 6-9 months, we are committed to moving at the pace that allows for wisdom, prayer, and unity rather than rushing a decision. Our ministries, worship, and mission will continue during this season. We are grateful for our interim leadership and staff who are faithfully serving during this transition. The "Eleventh Hour Prayer Group" meets on Tuesday mornings in the church's chapel from 11 am to Noon to pray for the church. We ask you to pray regularly for the SPRC, for the candidates God is preparing, and for our church to remain unified and hopeful as we trust the Lord together.


