Church Council Meeting

Our regularly scheduled Church Council meeting will be held Tuesday, July 25, 2023, at 7pm in the Faith Center.

Church Vote Postponed

Well, as most of you have heard, the upcoming August 20, 2023 vote on separating or staying UMC has been postponed until sometime after mid-January, 2024. The stated reason is because unfunded pension liability amounts can't be calculated until after January 1. This is a huge disappointment to some, but perhaps it will give us more clarity about God's plan for St. John's. It certainly gives us food for thought concerning the delay. Hopefully this time of waiting will be well-spent in further prayer and discernment. If anyone has had uncertainty, this delay should make things quite clear, by the grace of God. In the meantime, we will do what St. John's does best: "Serve, Love, and Worship with Passion!" Please be a part of the solution because the world needs us now more than ever to offer the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Potential Cost to Separate

The preliminary amounts to separate from the UMC have been calculated, except the smallest requirement, which is the unfunded pension liability, in which all UMs participate. This amount as of January 1, 2023 is \$25,000. We don't yet know what it will be next January, but most likely it will be reduced based upon higher interest rates and stock market improvement. The other items will have some variability, but will change very little or not at all. Presently, they are: \$228,000 for payments to the Annual Conference for apportionments; \$200,000 for 10% of our liquid assets; and \$539,000 which is based on the certified commercial appraisal of our property and buildings. This appraisal will not have to be redone by next year. The most drastic cost is the distraction to our focus on the mission of Christ. Please help St. John's to never lose that focus, especially over the next 6-plus months.
