## **SPRC Begins Sr. Pastor Search**

On Tuesday, August 19, a special Church Council meeting was called per the St. John's Book of Discipline, Par. 335.5(e) to authorize the Staff-Parish Relations Committee (SPRC) to begin the search for the new Senior Pastor. The SPRC voted to enter a contract with Vanderbloemen Search Firm, based out of Houston, Texas, who is currently serving St. John's for the vacant staff positions candidate searches. The SPRC intends to provide on-line and in-person opportunities to be made available for the congregations' input on qualities they desire for our future senior pastor candidate. Please be on the lookout in the church bulletin and email announcements for the schedule and dates of these input opportunities. We ask you to be in prayer for St. John's and the SPRC as we navigate this search together.
