FAQS

Teams

We will have 4 teams this year made up of kids from all grades and both genders. These teams are red, blue, green, and yellow, These teams are not associated with cabins and cabins will have kids from each team.

Cabins

We have done our very best to accommodate buddy requests based on registrations for camp. Your child will be in a room with leaders and other children from different ages and teams.

Medication

If your child will bring medications, please have them in their original containers with their name and the instructions for use. Please place them in a zippered baggie with your child's name written on the bag. There will be a registered nurse at the camp with us to help distribute any medication needed.

Lake Time

The kids will have the opportunity to swim in the lake. Our kids will have assigned times when the lake is allowed to be used and there will ALWAYS be a life guard and counselors with the kids at the pool!

Food

All meals will be provided from Quaker Hill. If your child has any dietary restrictions or allergies please let us know and we will be sure to accommodate for them.

Camp Store

The Camp Store will be open during free-time each day. Please send your child with cash if they want to purchase something from the store. They have candy, drinks, and camp merch available. The camp store is completely optional.

Eastwind Church Partnership

We are partnering with Eastwind Church again this year. Our kids will be in their own cabins and small groups with Stonehill folks, but will be on teams with both Stonehill and Eastwind kids.

Camper Mail

You have the option to send mail to your camper. We pass it out to kids at meal time each day. Please address as seen here and be sure to send your mail to give time for shipping. We suggest you send mail in the middle of the week so it isn't late.


