#### **FEAST UPDATES**

Stay in the loop!

#### **SAFETY & AWARENESS**

To help maintain a family-friendly and safe environment:

- Drive 5 MPH at all times.
- Park carefully—watch for children.
- Do not invite children into your tent or camper unless they're part of your household-Let's avoid even the appearance of impropriety as we honor Yahweh together.

#### **ACCOMMODATIONS & FACILITIES**

- Camp is divided into zones for lodging, meals, and activities.
- Keep areas clean—daily teams rotate (see schedule).
- Tent campers may use the freezer and fridge in the Dining Hall.
- No cooking in the Dining Hall or Activity Center kitchens.
- Dishwashing station is behind the main kitchen (east side).

#### **PETS**

No pets allowed, except for certified service animals.

#### **MEALS**

Families are responsible for their own meals.

- On Sabbaths & High Days, prepare ahead to focus on worship.
- Pitch-in lunches and select meals are on the schedule.

#### SERVICES & WORSHIP

- Services: 11 AM daily, 3 PM on High Days.
- No dancing during services—you're welcome to dance elsewhere.
- Children 10 & under must sit with an adult.
- No running in buildings.
- Nurseries are available in the Sanctuary & Dining Hall.
- Dining Hall & kitchen are locked during services.

#### **SPECIAL MUSIC**

Want to share a song? We'd love that! Please contact Aiden Hunt at (254) 433-3642 in advance. Max of 3 music offerings per service.

#### **GENERAL GUIDELINES**

#### **ACCOMMODATIONS**

Our campground is available for Feast guests at a modest cost to cover utilities and maintenance. The campus is divided into four zones, each with Neighborhood Hosts to assist you as needed.

- Tent campers may use the ice machine, fridge, and freezer in the Bathhouse.
- Additional ice machines are in the AC Lobby and Dining Hall.
- Please do not use kitchen appliances in the Main Kitchen or Activity Center.
- A laundry room is located on the east side of the Bathhouse.

#### **PETS**

No pets are allowed, except for certified service dogs for the blind.

#### **MEALS**

Everyone is responsible for their own meals.

- On Sabbaths, the Assembly provides a salad bar—please bring a dish to share.
- Invite your neighbors to join you for a meal and fellowship!
- Grill stations are open for use—please clean up after.
- The Main Kitchen is open after services until 9 PM; mornings are closed—plan on cold breakfasts.
- Microwaves and toasters are in the Dining Hall.
- Please observe biblical clean food laws while on campus.
- The Activity Center kitchen is closed during the Feast.

Let's honor Yahweh by caring for what He's given us.

- Clean up after yourself and your children.
- Join a daily cleanup team—see the schedule and map for your assigned area.
- Not camping? Ask a Cleaning Host how you can help.

### DRESS CODE

We value modesty and aim to create an environment that is respectful, family-friendly, and honoring to Yahweh. Please take a moment to review the following guidelines:

#### **GENERAL GUIDELINES (AGES 10 & UP):**

- Shirts should fully cover the midriff; necklines should be modest and not expose cleavage, even under lace or sheer material.
- Dresses, skirts, and shorts should approach the knee even when wearing leggings.
- Shorts are not permitted during formal worship services.

#### **PROHIBITED CLOTHING:**

- Sleeveless, strapless, spaghetti strap, backless, or coldshoulder tops and dresses
- Clothing that reveals undergarments, including bra straps
- Tank tops, muscle shirts, and form-fitting items like leggings, yoga pants, or compression shorts (unless worn under appropriately long garments)
- Clothing with inappropriate slogans, graphics, or references to alcohol or tobacco

#### A NOTE TO FIRST-TIME GUESTS:

If you're visiting for the first time and weren't aware of these guidelines, we completely understand. We're so glad you're here! We simply ask that you make any necessary adjustments as best you can. Thank you for your grace and willingness to help us maintain an atmosphere of reverence and unity.
