

## Firmly Rooted Bible Reading Plan

The **Firmly Rooted Plan** offers a guided way to stay connected to God's Word and story throughout the year. Adapted from **The Bible Project's One Story That Leads to Jesus** reading plan, it helps you trace the grand story of Scripture—from creation to new creation—at a manageable pace.

Each week includes five key passages plus one Psalm, giving you a rhythm that keeps you grounded in the Word while leaving space for reflection, prayer, and discussion.

- 1. This plan, Firmly Rooted is ideal for those seeking a steady, sustainable pace.
- 2. **Deeply Rooted** is a more comprehensive, read-through-the-Bible-in-a-year plan.

## Two Reading Plans with the Same Goal:

As time and energy allow, you may choose to go deeper by exploring the *Deeply Rooted Plan*—and if you fall behind or switch between plans, remember: there's grace here. Every page you read helps your roots grow stronger in God's story.

## How to Use the Plan:

- 1. Start with prayer. Invite the Holy Spirit to open your heart and guide your reading.
- Read the week's passages. Choose any order that fits your week—four readings plus one Psalm.
- 3. Reflect and respond. Note what stands out, journal a prayer, or share insights with your LinC group.
- 4. Stay grace-filled. This isn't about perfection—it's about presence. Let God meet you through His Word.
