





TOOLS THAT SERVE OUR DISCIPLE-MAKING MISSION

In 2025, Crossroads completed a comprehensive digital and brand refresh to better engage our church family and community in an increasingly mobile and visual world. Building on our last brand update in 2011, we invested over two and a half years upgrading key digital platforms, including our church management system, mobile app, and website, creating clearer communication and easier access to ministry resources.



With these foundations in place, our staff team undertook a thoughtful logo refresh, reviewing hundreds of concepts to arrive at a design that is flexible, recognizable, and aligned with who we are today. This refreshed look is now being implemented across digital platforms, signage, and materials.

More than a new logo, these efforts reflect our commitment to stewarding technology as a tool to help people encounter Jesus, connect at Crossroads, and live out our mission of making disciples who make disciples.

The Frame

"The Frame" serves as a foundational snapshot of who we are, what we do, why we do it, how we do it, and when we know we are successful. It provides clarity in purpose and action, ensuring that we remain aligned with the clear call to the Church according to the Scripture.

Think of it in terms of a special picture hanging on the wall of your house. The frame around the picture is important because it holds the picture. We don't typically have empty picture frames setting around the house. Why? Because the frame is not the central focus.

The frame is only important as it holds what it displays – the picture. This frame is important as it holds the beauty of the bride of Christ, the Church (Revelation 19:5-9; 21:9).



CONTINUE ON THE JOURNEY

It's about people and discipleship

Continue the Journey is our master design plan created to address Crossroads' growing need for space that supports people, relationships, and discipleship. While buildings don't make disciples, we believe that a thoughtfully designed facility can serve as a powerful tool, creating space for ministry, connection, and life-on-life discipleship to flourish.

Phase 1 of Continue the Journey is underway and scheduled for completion this June. Phases 2 and 3 will follow as God provides and leads. Each phase moves us closer to a facility that helps us love well, serve faithfully, and invest deeply in those God brings to Crossroads—both now and for future generations.

Ultimately, it is Christ who builds His Church. We simply want to be good stewards of the people He brings our way by loving them well, sharing the gospel, and helping them grow in Christ. Our building and property are tools that support this vision of being an authentic community of Christ followers.
