"Stand at the crossroads and look; ask for the ancient paths, ask where the good way is, and walk in it, and you will find rest for your souls.

17 I appointed watchmen over you and said,

1. Israel at the Crossroads

- Rebellion against God
 - Jeremiah prophesied during one of the darkest periods in Jewish history.
 - The people's rebellion against God had reached the point of no return.

Jeremiah 7:9-11

⁹ "'Will you steal and murder, commit adultery and perjury,^[a] burn incense to Baal and follow other gods you have not known, ¹⁰ and then come and stand before me in this house, which bears my Name, and say, "We are safe"—safe to do all these detestable things? ¹¹ Has this house, which bears my Name, become a den of robbers to you? But I have been watching! declares the LORD.

- God's hand of judgment was coming upon Israel through Nebuchadnezzar, king of Babylon (modern day Iraq).
- That judgment came in three major phases.
 - The first siege of Jerusalem. Following the siege of Jerusalem in 605 BCE, many Judeans, including the prophet Daniel, were taken to Babylon.
 - o Around 597 BCE, after another siege, more Judeans were deported.
 - The third siege came in 586 BCE which included the destruction of Jerusalem and the Temple of Solomon.
- The nation that once held such favor in God's eyes now found itself in complete bondage because of its rebellion.

2. America at the Crossroads

- Rebellion against God
 - We live in one of the darkest periods in America's history.

Let's read Jeremiah 7:9-11 again.

⁹ "Will you steal and murder, commit adultery and perjury, [a]</sup> burn incense to Baal and follow other gods you have not known, ¹⁰ and then come and stand before me in this house, which bears my Name, and say, "We are safe"—safe to do all these detestable things? ¹¹ Has this house, which bears my Name, become a den of robbers to you? But I have been watching! declares the LORD.

- o One of the latest Barna polls on Christianity in America reveals the following.
 - Americans are increasingly comfortable picking and choosing what they deem to be helpful and accurate theological views and have become comfortable discarding the rest of the teachings in the Bible.
 - Growing numbers of people now serve as their own theologian-inresidence. One consequence is that Americans are embracing an unpredictable and contradictory body of beliefs.
 - In the past, most people determined their theological and moral points of view from exclusively Christian options e.g., Methodist, Baptist, etc.
 - Today, Americans are more likely to "create" their own theology by combining Christian and non-Christian views. This has resulted in what can be called a "hodge-podge" worldview which may include some tenants of Christianity but also include ideas from other world religions such as Buddhism, Judaism, Hinduism, and Islam as well as secularism.
- A casual look around us reveals the lack of belief in the absolute truth of God's Word and of who God is.
- Has America reached the point of no return?
 - o Three sieges in America today.
 - The siege of godlessness.
 - The siege of immorality.
 - The siege of depravity.
- America: The nation that once held such favor in God's eyes now finds itself on the brink of complete bondage because of rebellion.

America IS at a crossroads.
