Purpose & Vision

Our purpose in the *Kingdom Kids Ministry* is to bring the word of God to your youngest members and attendees. Our vision is to help children to <u>K</u>now, <u>Love</u>, and <u>Commit to Jesus Christ and impact their environment for God's glory.</u>

In our classrooms, children are nurtured, engaged and encouraged to learn about God's love and commandments. Lessons will include structured and unstructured activities that will enhance their learning and that will point them to Jesus Christ through bible lessons, scripture, music, videos and hands-on activities.

Our commitment is to provide a safe, nurturing, and fun environment for the children to learn and grow spiritually. We depend upon God, the Holy Spirit, our spiritual disciplines, and the parents and guardian's help in promoting this Christian education.

As trained and experienced teachers, it is our desire to serve children each week and come alongside every adult in teaching the bible to children and trusting they will come to know and love God and commit to Jesus Christ and His purpose for their lives.

We believe God has given us the privilege of working with children, and entrusting us to deposit His word into their hearts and minds. Deuteronomy 6:6-7 is our foundation which says: "These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. Impress them on your children. Kingdom Kids Programs

Busy Bees (under two)

Our Nursery is for non-walkers and walkers under the age of two. We recognize that this is a critical time for learning at this age, so we utilize pictures, songs, and activities to teach our little ones that Jesus loves them.

Soaring Sprouts (two-five)

Our preschoolers are potty-trained toddlers and kindergartners, ages two through five. We maximize the learning experience of our preschoolers by incorporating free time as they learn about the love of Jesus through songs and lessons.

Great Explorers (1st-3rd)

Our Great Explorers class is for students in 1st through 3rd grade. At this age, we seek to create the optimal learning environment by incorporating small group instruction, hands-on activities, songs, and bible verses.

Faith Seekers (4th-5th)

Our Faith Seekers class is for children in grades 4th-5th. At this age, we focus on teaching biblical principles, such as the importance of prayer and service to the Lord. These principles help to prepare children for their transition to Youth Group.



POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

CHECK-IN/CHECK-OUT

Please RSVP for Kingdom Kids on the church's form prior to service. This is imperative for our teachers to be able to plan accordingly. Failure to do so may result in the inability for your child to attend.

Each child needs to be checked-in using our electronic system every Sunday prior to attending the worship service. Once you check-in, you and your child will be given matching identification tags. Your child will wear their nametag, which has a code matching your security tag. This will be needed to pick your child after service.

Children will be dismissed at the conclusion of service. You are required to pick up your child within ten minutes of service ending. Please be courteous of the teacher's time. Failure to comply may result in the inability of your child to attend Kingdom Kids.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

To ensure the health and safety of all of our children, children with colds, runny noses, fevers, rashes, or other symptoms of illness are not permitted in the classrooms.

During the COVID-19 pandemic masks are required to be worn by children over the age of two.

If your child has any allergies or special conditions, please be sure to make Kingdom Kids staff aware.

PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES

As we grow our children into the next generation of servants for our Lord, it is important that they see the adults in their lives in a relationship with Jesus Christ. At Kingdom Life Church, it is a requirement of our parents to volunteer in the classroom <u>at minimum</u> six times per year. Your date of volunteering will be assigned with 4-6 weeks advance notice.

Please review and return the behavior agreement with your child.
