**Over the past year**, we have invited you into what we call the “Creekside Commitments”! These are three grace-filled rhythms that we’d love for all Creekside members to live in. Each of these practices engage us in living like Jesus so we can love like Jesus. Each is rooted in Scripture and modeled by Jesus and the apostles.

The Morning & Evening Commitment invited us to start and end each day by turning our attention to God through quiet moments spent with Him and in His word.

The Fasting & Feasting Commitment invited us to a regular practice of self-denial and celebration through fasting and feasting.

### GATHERING & GOING

Across the pages of Scripture, we see clear priority given to the consistent assembling of God’s people. We also find a recurring theme of dispersment or sending. In each case, we find God emphasizing our proximity to others as vital. We commit to a weekly rhythm of gathering in community with our church family and then going on mission into the world around us.

# Wednesday Electives

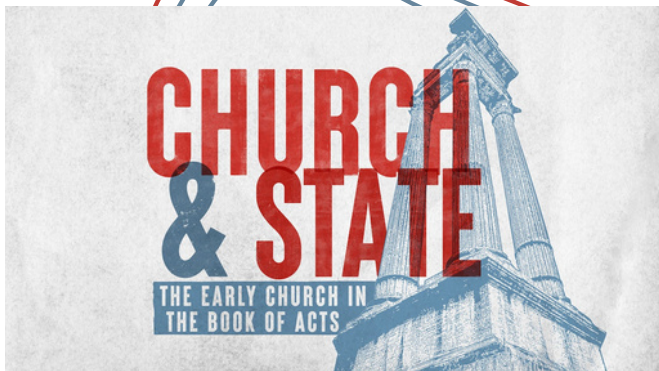
