### We Can't All Be Right, But We Could All Be Wrong

When Bible students take all of the pieces of the prophecy puzzle and attempt to put them together, they come out with a vast variety of possibilities. Some of these can be eliminated quickly because the other biblical prophecies have all been fulfilled literally. The basic and required pieces include: 1. Jesus returning visibly as He said, and like the angels promised (Matt. 24:27-30, 26:64, Acts 1:9-11) 2. That He is coming as the Son of God to destroy His enemies literally bringing judgment and setting up His literal kingdom for 1000 years over all the earth reigning from Jerusalem (Matt. 25: 31-46, Rev. 19:19-21, Rev. chapters 19-20) But these examples, we will more thoroughly examined in the message today and the blog to follow.

This Jesus who is returning visibly to the world is also coming invisibly for His bride- the Church. This same Jesus is sharing messages with the churches, and with us today, with details of the last 7 years of the world as we know it. Blessed is those who read, hear, and heed! We can't all be right, but we could all be wrong. Regardless, the important thing is whether you have responded to the call of God for salvation through His Son Jesus, The Christ.

# The Lord's Supper, August 31

Prepare yourself, before you come on **Sunday, August 31** for The Lord's Supper. The key to the most meaningful Lord's Supper celebration is the proper preparation. "Therefore whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner, shall be guilty of the body and the blood of the Lord. But a man must examine himself, and in so doing he is to eat of the bread and drink of the cup. For he who eats and drinks, eats and drinks judgment to himself if he does not judge the body rightly. For this reason many among you are weak and sick, and a number sleep. But if we judged ourselves rightly, we would not be judged. But when we are judged, we are disciplined by the Lord so that we will not be condemned along with the world." (1 Corinthians 11:27–32)
