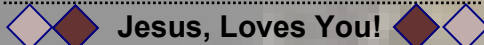

# THE Cypress Heart

We began our series through Paul's letter to the Colossians looking at how Paul was encouraging believers to remember that **Christ is supreme and therefore sufficient for our salvation**. In doing so, Paul was taking steps to combat the "Colossian Heresy" that was affecting the Colossian church, a heresy that a believer needed Christ plus something else. Paul reminds us that **all we need is Christ and Christ alone**. It is **in Christ that we are made complete, we are victorious, and we are free from legalism**. The heart of the gospel is that we were dead in our trespasses, but made alive. We were guilty, but God forgave. We were enslaved, but Christ won the victory.

Where do we go from there? In Colossians 3, Paul tells us to **Live the Risen Life**. Because we have been raised with Christ, **we are called to live lives that reflect His character** – in purity, love, and relational harmony.

*"Since you have been raised to new life with Christ, set your sights on the realities of heaven, where Christ sits in the place of honor at God's right hand. Think about the things of heaven, not the things of earth. For you died to this life, and your real life is hidden with Christ in God. And when Christ, who is your life, is revealed to the whole world, you will share in all his glory."*

(Colossians 3:1-4, NLT)
