Why The Transfiguration and Palm Sunday?

Every miracle that Jesus performed at the leading of His Father was a proof of His Messiahship. In simple terms, these were not things that people could do so they pointed to Jesus as the God/man; the Son of God. One of those more personal events was the Transfiguration found in Matthew 17:1, Mark 9:1 and Luke 9:28. In each case, what Jesus taught just before this event is significant to the even. People were about to see the Kingdom of God on earth even if it was a limited audience. God the Father would speak about His Son, just as He had spoken about His Son at the baptism of Jesus. Jesus fulfilled the ministry of John the Baptist by being baptized by John, so as John said, the ministry of Jesus would increase as the ministry of John decreased. Palm Sunday, which is on the holy calendar for next Sunday, was an acknowledgement of the fulfillment of the prophecy of the prophet Daniel, The people would have known that Jesus was fulfilling Daniel 9:24-26, Isaiah 62:11, and Zechariah 9:9. As we learn to obey regardless of the cost, we see that God affirms His servants and confirms their ministry. What God is doing in the world in not a series of random events. When you and I serve God, we are part of the grand scheme of redemption, salvation, sanctification, and glorification of His saints. As a born again child of God, your life matters more than you know. Wake up and see that it is true. Join in on the divine appointments and lay up treasures in Heaven.

Exterior concrete work with our contractor is nearing completion with the last of the installation finishing next week. Electrical work has begun and will continue for the next 3 weeks, we will complete the last of the exterior work (between north and middle buildings) and the last of the minor brick touch up’s. We will soon begin some of the slower less noticeable work inside as framing and bracing are nearing completion.
