Why The Transfiguration and Palm Sunday?

Every miracle that Jesus performed at the leading of His Father was a proof of His Messiahship. In simple terms, these were not things that people could do so they pointed to Jesus as the God/man; the Son of God. One of those more personal events was the Transfiguration found in Matthew 17:1, Mark 9:1 and Luke 9:28. In each case, what Jesus taught just before this event is significant to the even.
