I See Dead People

Jesus walked throughout the land of Israel, Samaria, and into Lebanon during His public ministry. As the Lord of Life, He was surrounded by the spiritually dead. His half brothers, His friends, His neighbors, they were all spiritually dead. In fact, everywhere He looked He saw a few people who were spiritually alive, but most of them were spiritually dead. The Bible says that, “the wages of sin is death” and “for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God”. Spiritually speaking this world is full of spiritual zombies- the walking dead. Jesus was always reaching out to the spiritual dead to bring them life. When Jesus was calling people to follow Him, we have this conversation: “But He said to him, “Allow the dead to bury their own dead; but as for you, go and proclaim everywhere the kingdom of God.”” (Luke 9:60, NASB95) As Jesus began what has been referred to as the passion week, which leads to His crucifixion, He brought Lazarus back to life who was a living spirit because of his faith in Jesus. This miracle showed that He was the Lord of life. Jesus would lay down His life, as the sacrificial lamb for the sin of the world. Because of Jesus, we can, by faith in Him, have spiritual life. The amazing thing about the spiritual life He gives is that it is eternal. By faith in Jesus alone for salvation we can be born twice and only die once (physical death). If we reject the call of Jesus, we will only be born once, but we will die twice. ““But for the cowardly and unbelieving and abominable and murderers and immoral persons and sorcerers and idolaters and all liars, their part will be in the lake that burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death.”” (Revelation 21:8, NASB95) Notice the word that indicates that unbelief is a reason to spend eternity separated from God. But look at this, ““He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. He who overcomes will not be hurt by the second death.”” (Revelation 2:11, NASB95) So how do we overcome? “For whatever is born of God overcomes the world; and this is the victory that has overcome the world—our faith. Who is the one who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?” (1 John 5:4–5, NASB95)

Prepare yourself this week, before you come Next Sunday, Resurrection Sunday **March 31** for The Lord's Supper. The key to the most meaningful Lord's Supper celebration is the proper preparation. "Therefore whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner, shall be guilty of the body and the blood of the Lord. But a man must examine himself, and in so doing he is to eat of the bread and drink of the cup. For he who eats and drinks, eats and drinks judgment to himself if he does not judge the body rightly. For this reason many among you are weak and sick, and a number sleep. But if we judged ourselves rightly, we would not be judged. But when we are judged, we are disciplined by the Lord so that we will not be condemned along with the world." (1 Corinthians 11:27-32)

Property & Space Phase II Work

Exterior concrete work with our contractor is nearing completion with the last of the installation finishing next week. Electrical work has begun and will continue for the next 3 weeks, we will complete the last of the exterior work (between north and middle buildings) and the last of the minor brick touch up's. We will soon begin some of the slower less noticeable work inside as framing and bracing are nearing completion.

We appreciate all the prayers and volunteers that have helped us to get to the point. This volunteer support has saved the Church over \$180K in labor cost.
