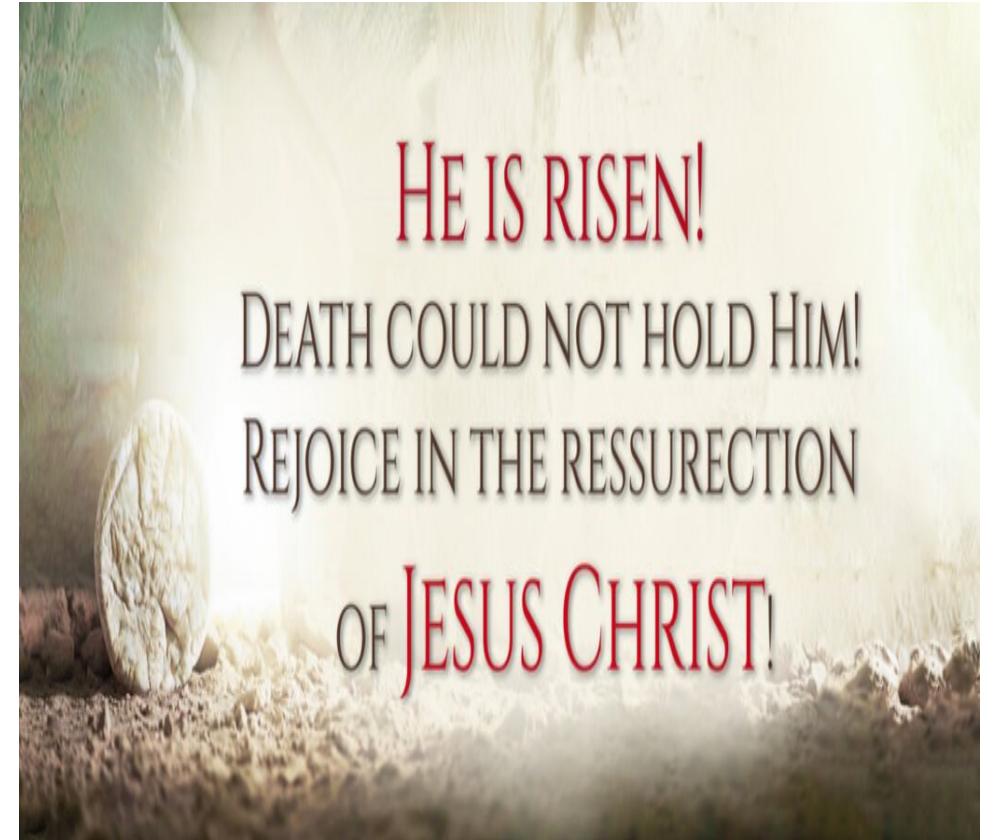

Property & Space Phase II Work

We know we have a mess outside... But that will be cleaned up as soon as its starts drying up and exterior work finishes up. We are so grateful for all the help we've had; this help has easily put us at least a month ahead of our original schedule,. Thanks to everyone for your continued prayers and support. Besides being ahead of schedule, we are well within our budget. Savings to the church through volunteer help have now surpassed \$224K in labor cost.

Electrical work is underway and will continue for the next week or two. Exterior trim work is nearing completion with roofing of the building and connecting hallway between north and middle education buildings starting next week. Exterior brick work in complete with final touch- ups. HVAC work is underway and will continue for another week and two inside.

We are finishing up some of the slower less noticeable work inside. In the next 2-3 weeks wall insulation and sheet rock will begin.
