This is a much better choice than sending mass mailings that simply go in the trash. As we get these resources together, they will become the base of a new outreach program. These 'gifts' of information about our community, our church, and our future plans will also be available to those who want to bless a neighbor with an invitation to LCBC.



#### Renovations

The Property and Space committee has been used by the Lord to make amazing progress on the old sanctuary that will ultimately become an adult education building. Priming and painting the interior of the building will start soon. Doors will be hung, the drop-in ceiling will be installed, and flooring is ordered; in other words, things are coming together by their hard work led by the grace of God.



#### Phase 2

The Phase Two committee will be hearing from our architects this month with bids from the general contractors who were invited to submit bids. These costs will give us the opportunity to imagine what the ultimate costs might be.

Also, we will have our fellowship afterwards so bring your favorite finger foods to share.


#### Youth
