INTRODUCTION: Read our passage.

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION:

1. **Refining the Focus:** In verse 2, Moses says, "The Lord is my strength and my song; he has become my salvation." What is the difference between knowing God is strong and claiming Him as your strength?

2. **The Attributes of God:** Read through verses 3–12. List the specific characteristics of God mentioned here (e.g., "Warrior," "Majestic in power"). Which of these attributes resonates with you most in your current season of life?
3. **Physical Expression:** Verse 20 mentions Miriam leading the women with timbrels and dancing. Why do you think physical expression (music, movement) is often a part of how we respond to God's work?
4. **Uniqueness:** Verse 11 asks, "Who among the gods is like you, Lord?" In our modern context, what "gods" or idols do people often trust in for security, and how does the Lord prove superior to them?

BREAKOUT SESSIONS:

Prayer Focus: Pray for ongoing outreach and missions, people in our body, and for our leaders.

Personal Practical Application: What was the most significant truth God showed you this week? How can you apply that to your life today?
