While we await the cooler Fall temperatures, we are busy with our usual Fall events, such as the Fall Festival (October 26th) and the Feast of Thanks (November 2nd). Many of you remember that we started a new tradition last year called our "Friends & Family Day". A day where we encourage you to invite those within your sphere of influence to join us for worship. This year, we have combined our Friends & Family Day with our Fall Festival to maximize our efforts & effectiveness. In other words, we are encouraging you, the body of Christ here at Lakewood, to make every effort to invite your unchurched friends & family on this day. Our prayer is that God will bring people who need to hear the lifesaving message of the Gospel to our campus on this day.

To make this effort as successful as possible, we are mobilizing our church body to get outside the four walls of the church. On Sunday afternoon, October 5th & 12th from 3-5 pm, we will gather at the FAC, split into groups, & go to the neighborhoods around the church. We have printed invite cards & door hangers for this effort. These simple cards convey information about the Fall Festival & give them some information about the church. Furthermore, on Wednesday nights, we have been engaged in a series called "Easy Evangelism", which is simplified training on how to share our faith more boldly. Even if you haven't been a part of this training, we encourage you to eschew fear & be used by God to advance His Kingdom.

On October 5th & 12th, our students & young adults will also be placing our Annual LOAF Food Drive bags out in the community. This food drive helps stock our food closet shelves

for the increased need we experience during the holiday season. There will certainly be a lot of Lakewood representatives walking the neighborhoods around the church on these days. To add to the student ministry's efforts, we are also having another food drive contest within the church. Visit the downstairs elevator lobby to see the donation boxes with the staff pictures on them. If you remember earlier this year, we had a Polar Plunge Challenge where all four of our pastoral staff had to get wet in the cold creek behind the church. I can testify that Charles absolutely loved that cold water! This time, we have rented a dunking booth for the Fall Festival. The staff member with the largest number of items donated will be the first to get wet. You can decide whether they are the biggest winner or the biggest loser! Let's all get behind this effort & have some fun while doing it!

We are looking for & planning other ways to mobilize our people to be the church to the community God has planted us in. Listen for more announcements that are soon to come on how we can represent Christ to the people outside our four walls.
