

Seed & Consent Guidelines

Stewardship, Integrity, and Apostolic Order

Deliverance is a sacred ministry, not a transaction. At Corner Stone Deliverance Church, we do not sell freedom. We steward transformation. These guidelines clarify how we honor both the ministry and those who receive it.

1. Seed of Honor

We invite every participant to sow a **voluntary seed** in recognition of the spiritual labor, preparation, and discernment invested in each session.

- This seed is not a fee; it is a **faith-based offering**.
- It reflects biblical stewardship and honors those who minister (Galatians 6:6).
- Suggested seed amounts may be provided based on session type.
- No one will be denied ministry due to financial hardship.
- Seeds may be sown via our website giving page (see link below) or in person.

"Let the one who is taught the word share all good things with the one who teaches." — Galatians 6:6

2. Consent to Minister

Before receiving ministry, each participant must review and sign a **Consent to Minister** form. This affirms:

- You understand the spiritual nature of deliverance.
- You are voluntarily participating and not under coercion.
- You agree to follow the intake process and post-care instructions.
- You release the ministry from liability for outcomes beyond spiritual counsel and prayer.

3. Confidentiality & Boundaries

We uphold strict confidentiality and minister within clear spiritual boundaries:

- Sessions are private and conducted with pastoral oversight.
- We do not record sessions or share personal information.
- We reserve the right to postpone or decline ministry if spiritual alignment is not present.

4. Follow-Up & Accountability

Deliverance is a process. We encourage:

- Continued discipleship and pastoral covering.
- Use of the Post-Deliverance Care Guide.
- Accountability through prayer partners or spiritual mentors.
