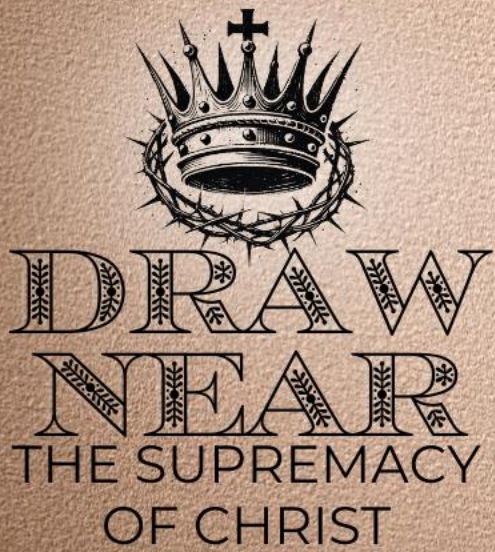

*The Epistle to the Hebrews:
In Christ, God has invited
us to draw near.*





1. The God who bids us draw near is for us, not against us. He is the “God of peace.”



2. The God who bids us draw near has acted decisively in Christ, the “Good Shepherd” who gave up His life for His flock.





3. The God who bids us draw near has not only rescued us; He goes with us on the way, equipping us to serve Him.

harden our hearts so that we
