

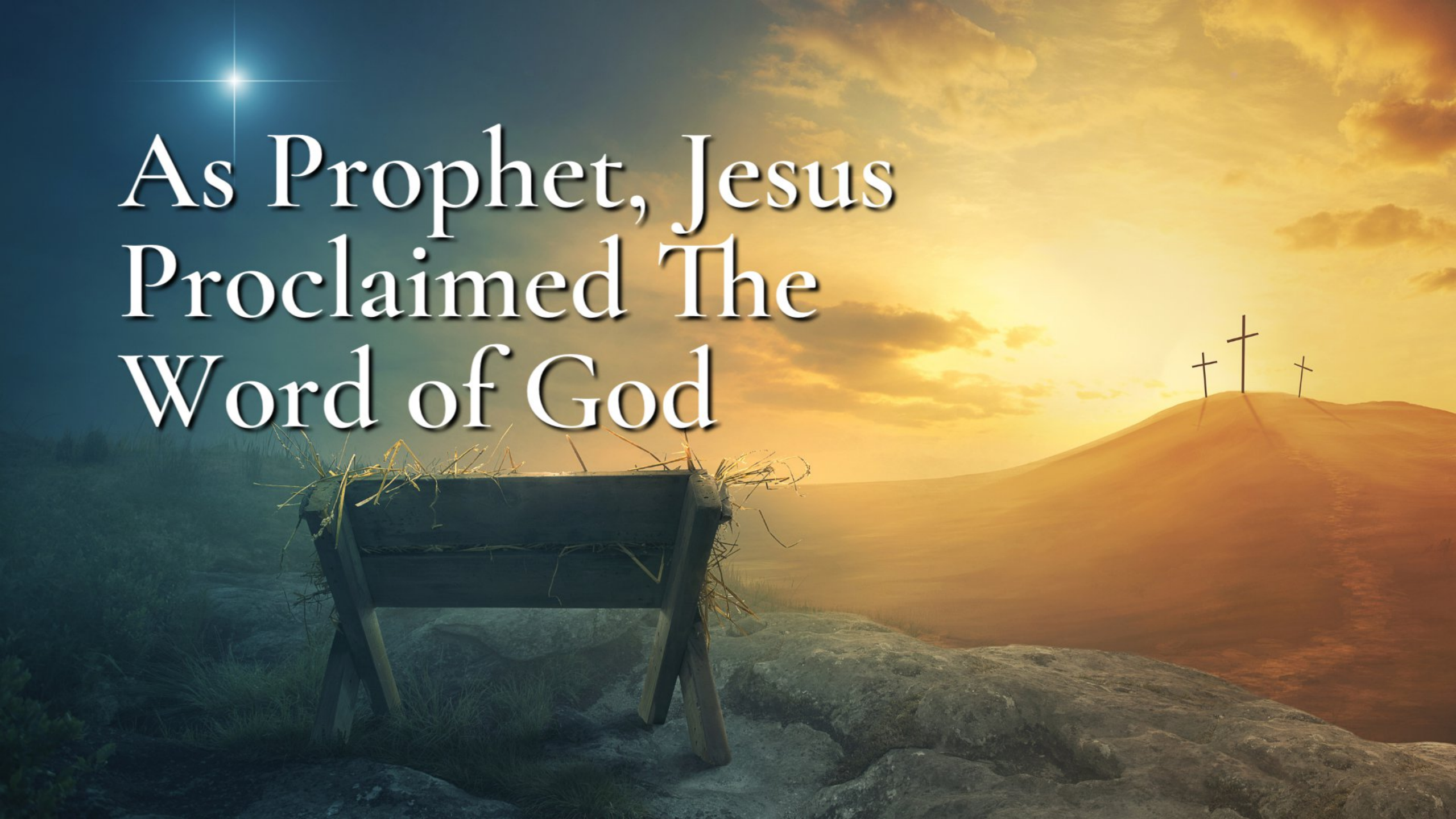


*Christ's Prophetic Work Is to

 - As king, he sovereignly rules over all things



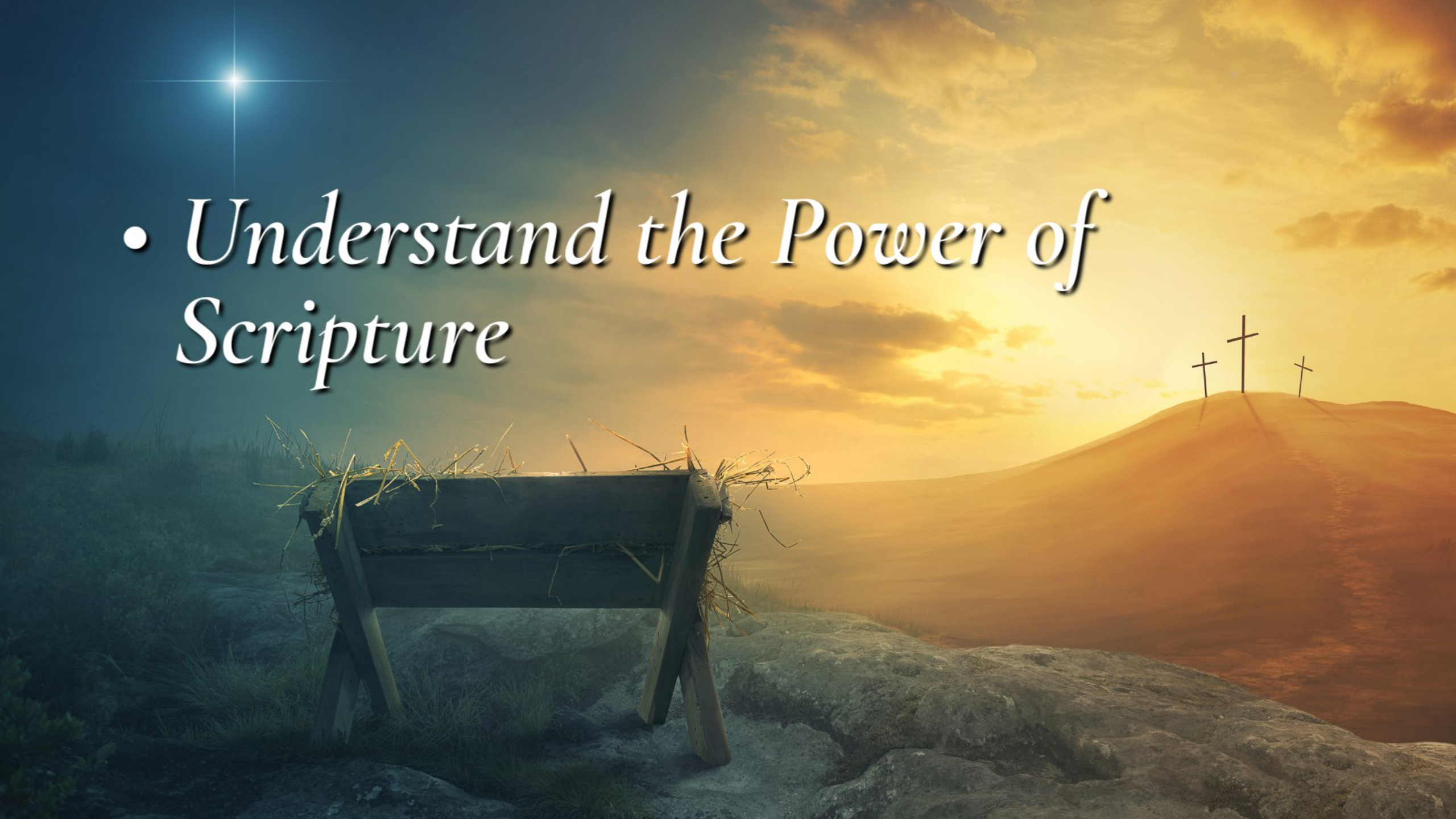
As a Prophet, His Words
