








BI Spy! &






POM Teru'dh

The Israelites often anointed kings on this day.




> Make a crown for a king! &

You will need:


- I. Heavy card stock
- 2. Paint, felt pens, or crayons
- 3. Scissors (adult only)
- 4. Extra-strength glue sticks or tape

Instructions:

- I. Cut out the crown and long rectangles on the next page.
- 2. Ask your child to decorate their crown however they like.
- 3. When they have finished decorating their crown, glue the long strips of paper to the sides of the crown.
- 4. Measure your child's head and glue into a crown. Use a glue stick or tape to do this.





The Sabbath &


The Day of Trumpets is a Sabbath (Leviticus 23). The Sabbath is day of rest for G-D's people.




> Make a shofar &

The Day of Trumpets means 'the day of the shofar blast' in Hebrew. Let's make a shofar!



Instructions:

- I. Roll a large paper plate into a cone shape. Fasten with tape.
- 2. Glue construction paper around the cone shape. Use markers, ribbon or paint to decorate your 'shofar'.
- 3. Thread a piece of yarn through the inside of your shofar. Tie the ends to make a handle.






& Shofer





Repentance is turning back to G-D and doing things His way instead of our own way.



When Jonah was swallowed by a fish, he repented. He wanted to do things G-D's way instead of his own way. Draw Jonah inside the fish.








The High Priest wore a special breastplate of gems. Each stone had the name of one of the twelve tribes of Israel. Color the picture.








& Create a door hanger &


You will need:

- I. Heavy card stock or construction paper
- 2. Paint, felt pens, or crayons
- 3. Scissors (adult only)
- 4. Extra-strength glue sticks or tape

Instructions:

- I. Print as many door hanger templates as you need and paste onto heavy card stock. Carefully cut out each template.
- 2. Ask your children to color the Fall Feasts circles. When they have finished, cut out and paste the circles onto the door hangers.
- 3. Make a reversible door hanger by pasting two templates together, back-to-back.
- 4. When the children have finished creating their door hangers, laminate or seal each door hanger using clear laminating sheets.






