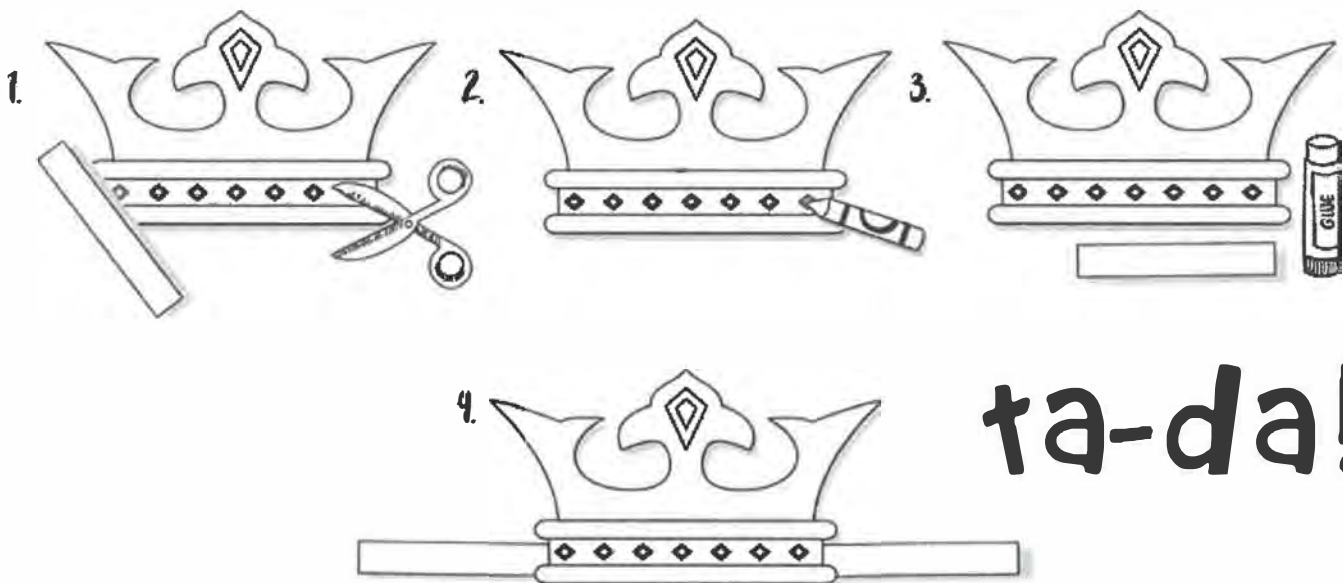
🌿 Make a crown for a king! 🌿

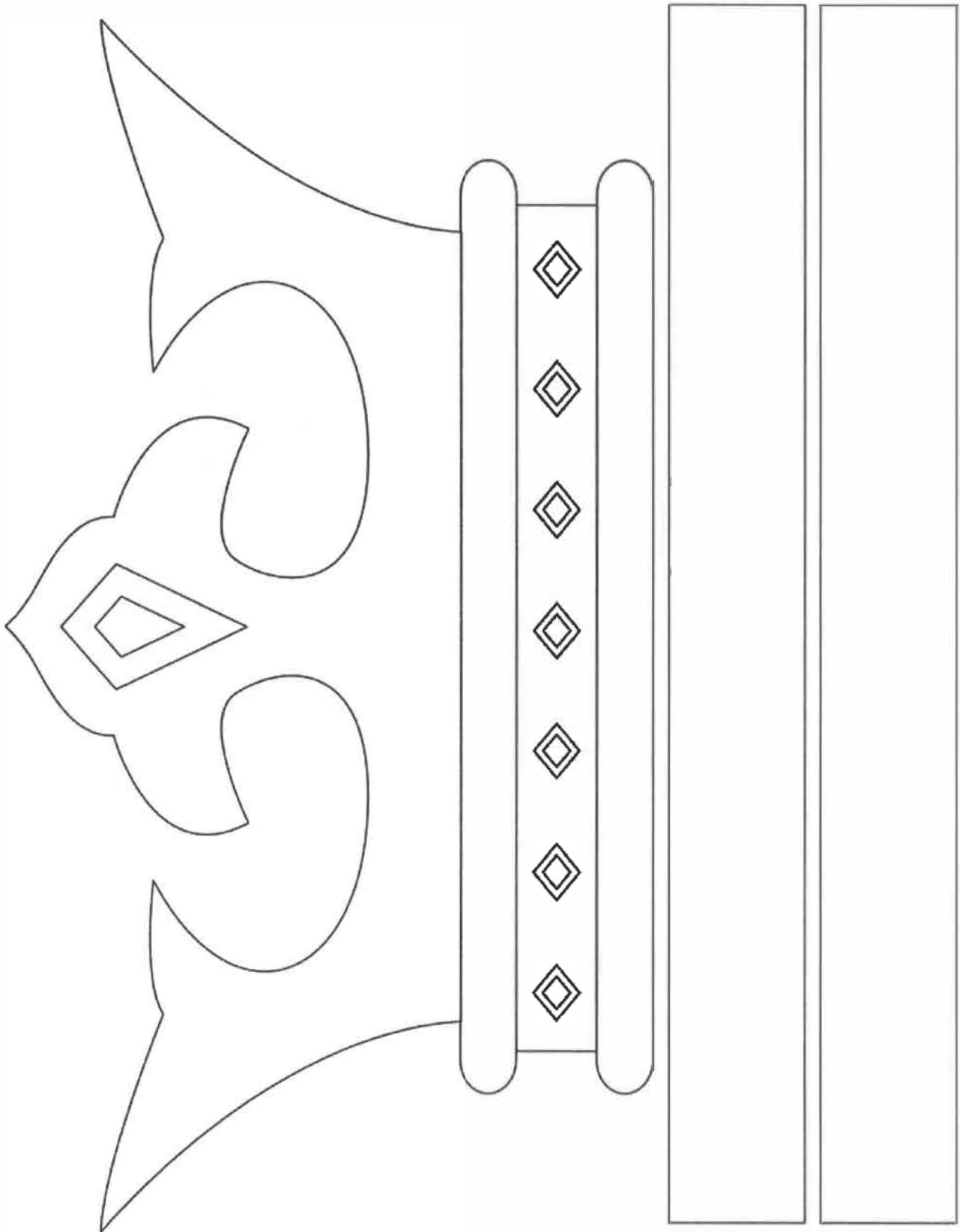
You will need:

2. Paint, felt pens, or crayons
3. Scissors (adult only)
4. Extra-strength glue sticks or tape

Instructions:

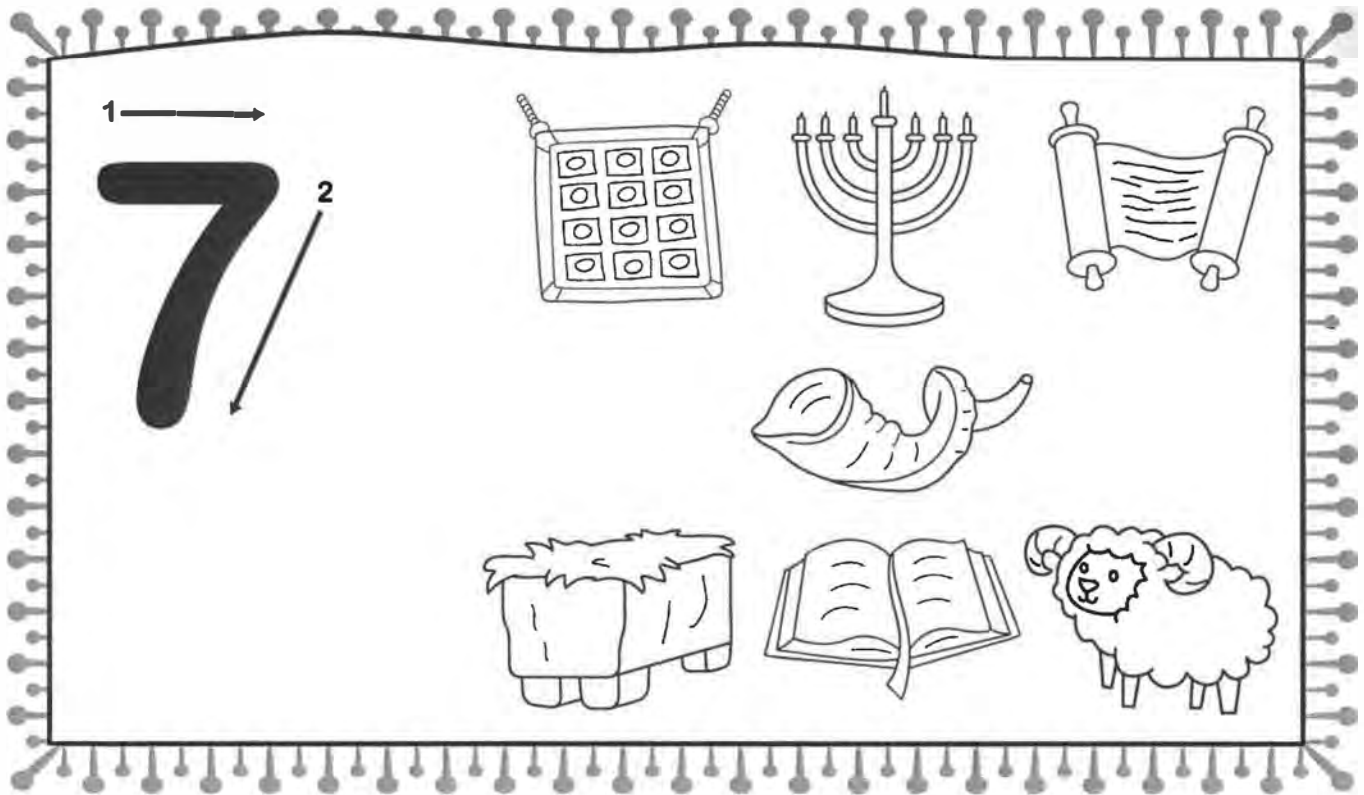
1. Cut out the crown and long rectangles on the next page.
2. Ask your child to decorate their crown however they like.
3. When they have finished decorating their crown, glue the long strips of paper to the sides of the crown.
4. Measure your child's head and glue into a crown. Use a glue stick or tape to do this.

🌿 Make a shofar 🌿

The Day of Trumpets means 'the day of the shofar blast' in Hebrew. Let's make a shofar!

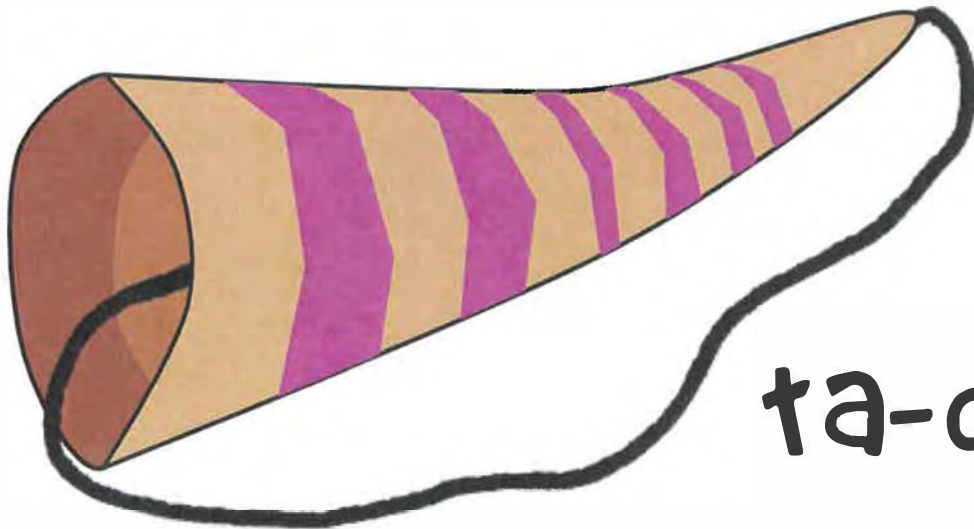


You will need:

1. Large paper plate
2. Construction paper
3. Tape and glue
4. Scissors (adults-only)
5. Paint, markers, ribbon, and yarn

Instructions:

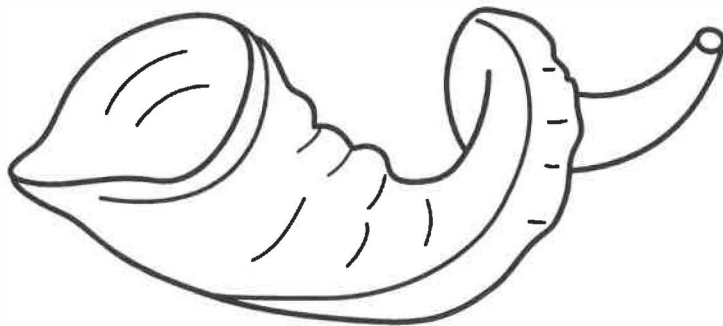
1. Roll a large paper plate into a cone shape. Fasten with tape.
2. Glue construction paper around the cone shape. Use markers, ribbon or paint to decorate your 'shofar'.
3. Thread a piece of yarn through the inside of your shofar. Tie the ends to make a handle.

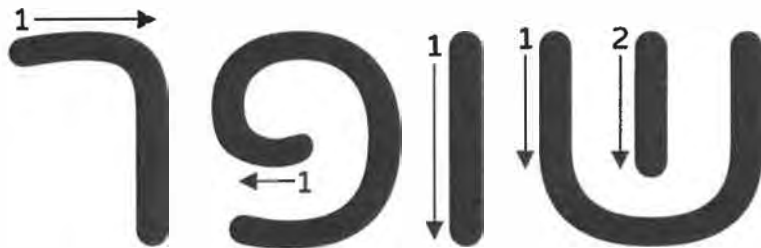
The Hebrew word for trumpet is shofar.

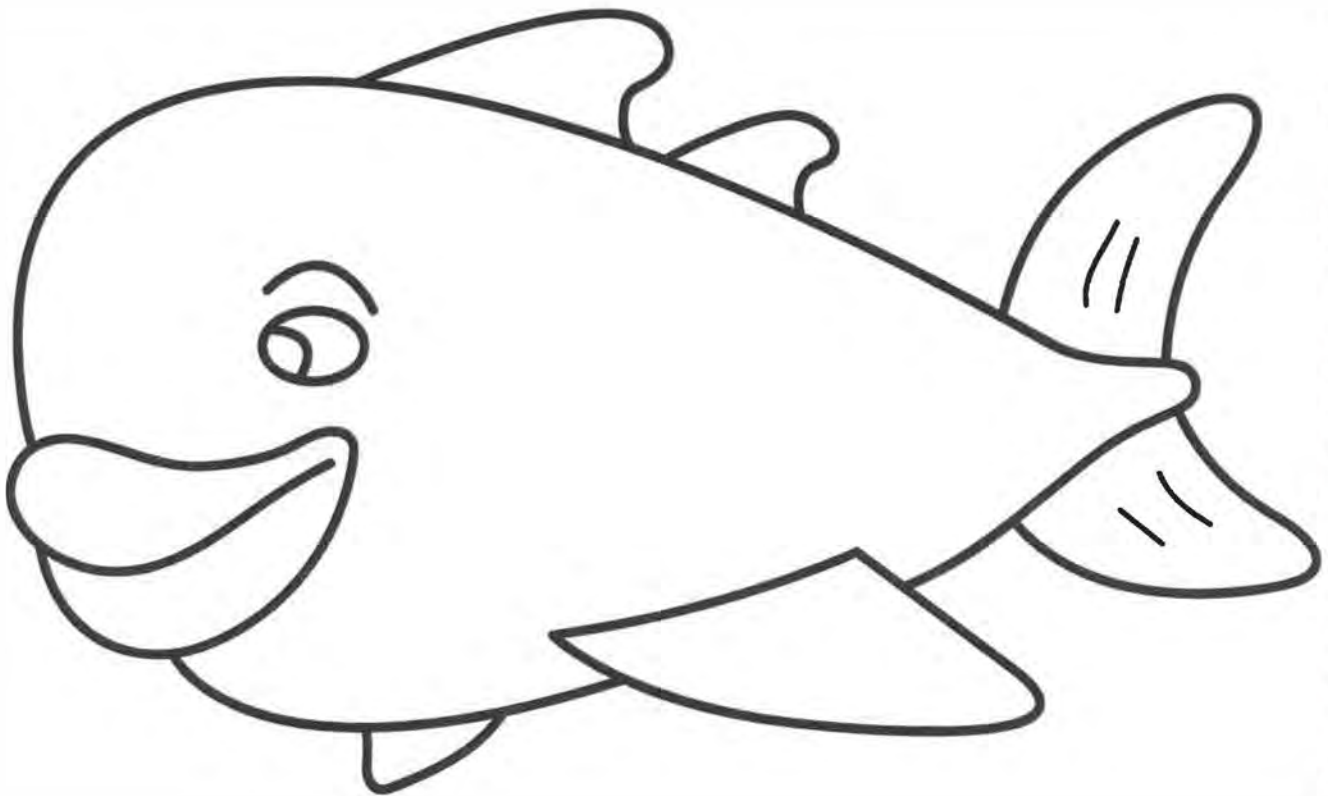

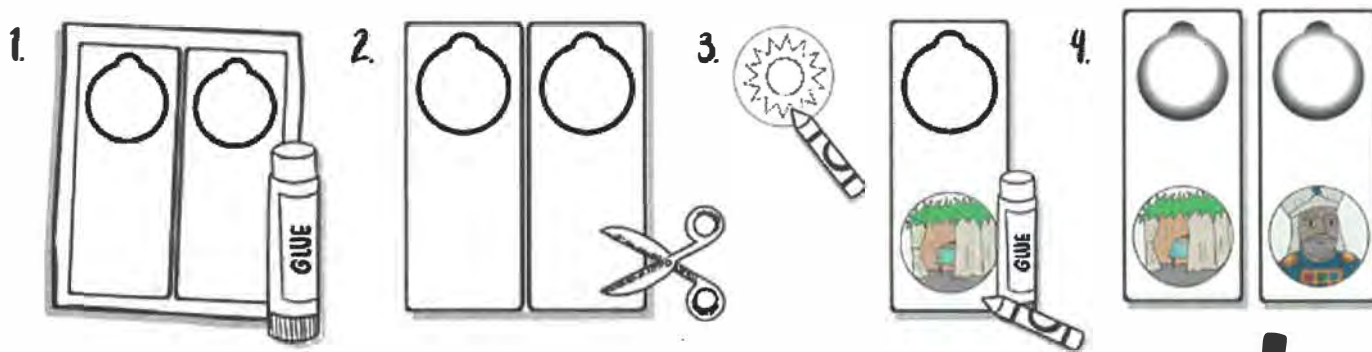
Create a door hanger

You will need:

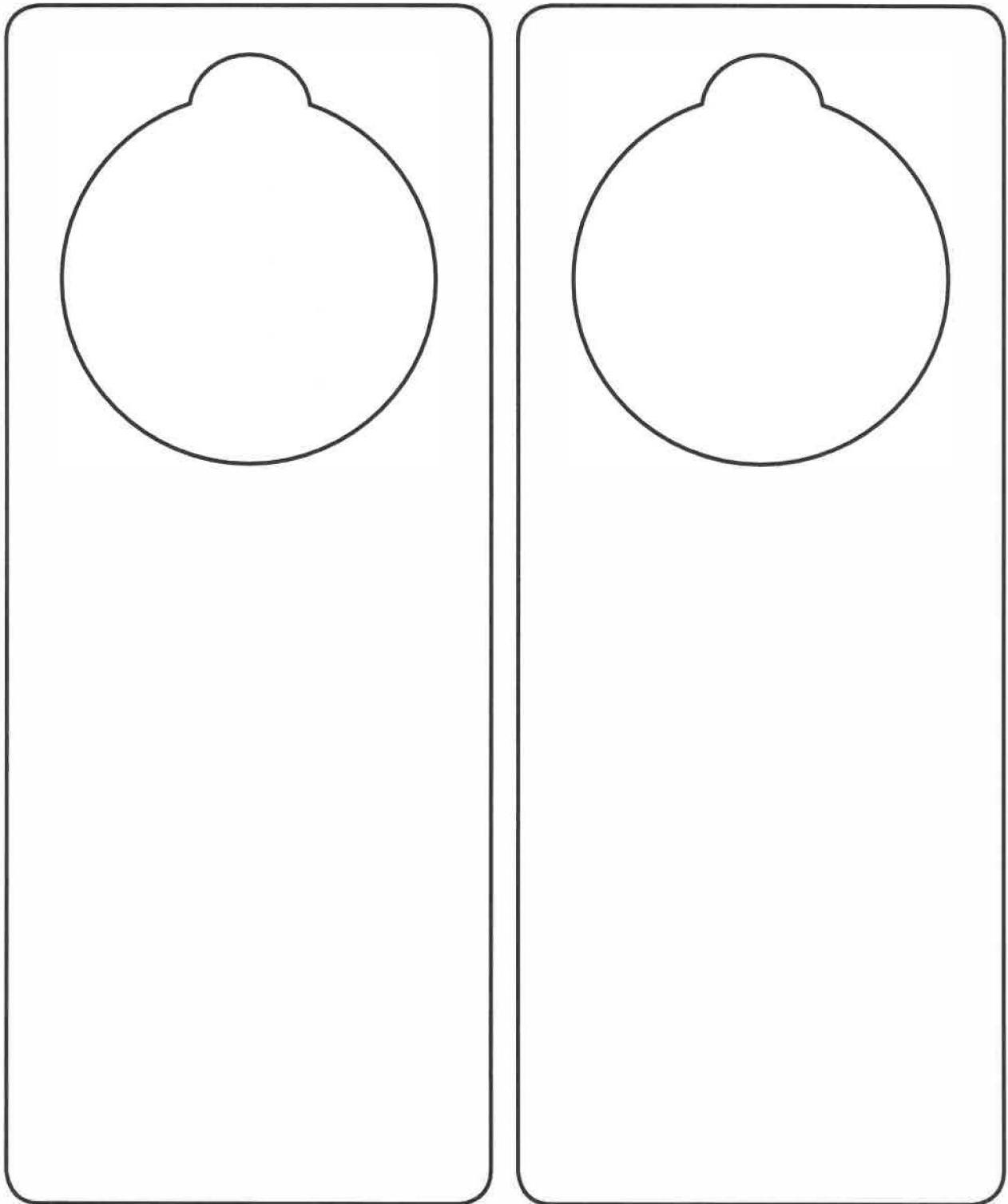
1. Heavy card stock or construction paper
2. Paint, felt pens, or crayons
3. Scissors (adult only)
4. Extra-strength glue sticks or tape

Instructions:

1. Print as many door hanger templates as you need and paste onto heavy card stock. Carefully cut out each template.
2. Ask your children to color the Fall Feasts circles. When they have finished, cut out and paste the circles onto the door hangers.
3. Make a reversible door hanger by pasting two templates together, back-to-back.
4. When the children have finished creating their door hangers, laminate or seal each door hanger using clear laminating sheets.
