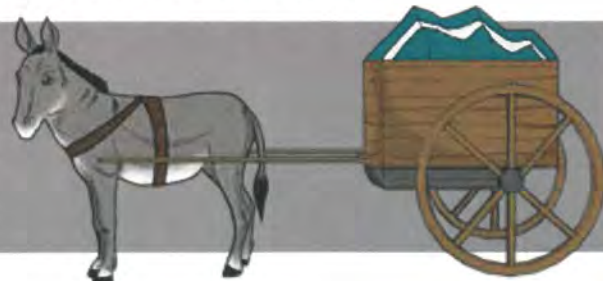

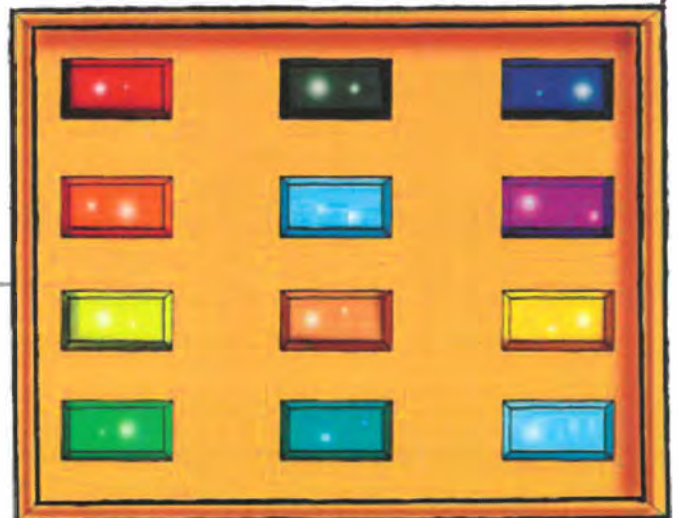

Open your Bibles and read the Bible verses below.
