Say: Shanah; Lev (encourage them to repeat the word lev, and put your hand over your heart)

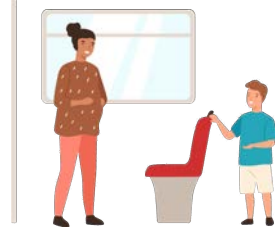
Read: Shemot 35:22-29

²²So they came, both men and women, everyone whose heart compelled him, and brought nose rings, earrings, signet rings, bracelets, and all kinds of golden jewels—everyone who brought a wave offering of gold to Adonai. ²³Everyone who had blue, purple, scarlet, fine linen, goat hair, ram skins dyed red or sealskins brought them. ²⁴Everyone who could make a contribution of silver or bronze brought Adonai's offering, and every man who had acacia wood of any use for service brought it. ²⁵Also all the women who were wise-hearted spun with their hands, and brought what they had woven—the blue, purple, scarlet and fine linen. ²⁶All the women whose heart stirred them up with wisdom spun the goat hair. ²⁷Also the leaders brought onyx stones and setting stones for the ephod and for the breastplate, ²⁸along with the spice, the oil for the light and for anointing and for the sweet incense. ²⁹Every man and woman whose heart made them willing gave toward all the work that Adonai had commanded to be done by Moses' hand.
