## HEBREW LETTER OF THE MONTH OF TISHREI

This month's letter of the alef-bet is Tav. It is the twenty-second and last letter of the alef-bet. Say: "Tav" it makes same sound as English letter “T”. Which is made by smiling with your teeth opened and placing the tip of your tongue on your top teeth and puffing out your breath in a short burst. The tav is one part of a name G-D calls HIMSELF: The Aleph-Tav appears thousands of times throughout the Torah, and there are several key passages where the placement of Aleph-Tav carries profound meaning—especially when looking at prophecy about Yeshua. Look at the items that begin with the letter tav; can you read the names aloud? Place your finger underneath the letters and remember that Hebrew is read from right to left.

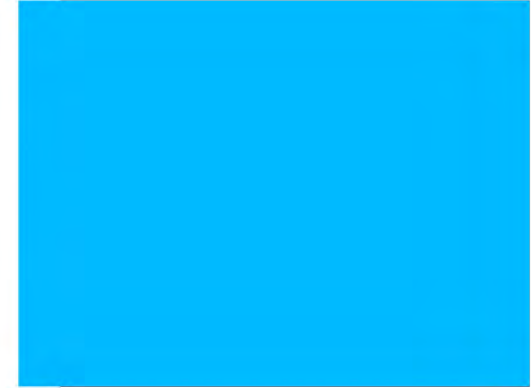
Show them the picture. Trace the letter with your finger and say "tav", then take their index finger, gently trace over the letter, repeat.


