HEBREW LETTER OF THE MONTH OF ELUL

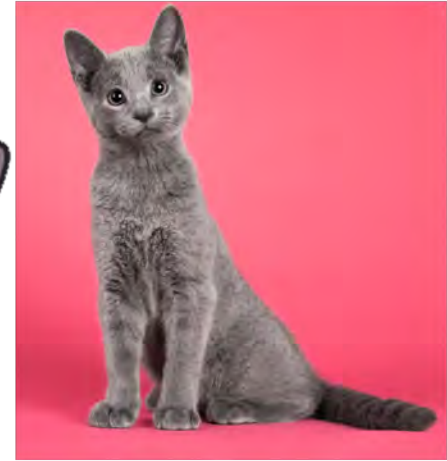
This month's letter of the alef-bet is Sin. It is the twenty-first letter of the alef-bet. Say: Sin makes same sound as English letter “S”. Which is made by smiling with your teeth closed and breathing out. The letter sin is a variation of the Hebrew letter Shin with the dagesh (little dot) on the left side. A friend of mine says "If it is not right it is 'Sin'" to help her remember that when the dagesh is on the left side it is "sin" and on the right side it is the letter "Shin". Look at the items that begin with the letter sin. The cursive of this letter looks like our English letter e. There are many pictures below that begin with the letter sin; can you read the names aloud? Place your finger underneath the letters and remember that Hebrew is read from right to left.

HEBREW LETTER OF THE MONTH OF ELUL

Show them the picture. Trace the letter with your finger and say “sin” then take their index finger and gently trace over the letter, repeat.

 5. Ye - shua loves me! He will stay Close be - side me all the way;




Lit - tle ones to Him be - long; They are weak, but He is strong.
