HEBREW LETTER OF THE MONTH OF CHESHVAN

This month's letter of the alef-bet is Alef. It is the first letter of the alef-bet. Say: "Alef". Alef is very special letter in that it makes no sound of its own, but is dependent upon the nikudim for its voice. Which means sometimes it says Ahh and sometimes it says Ehh. Sometimes this letter says Eee, or Ohhh, and Oooh, and it has short vowel sounds too! The alef is one part of a name G-D calls HIMSELF: The Aleph-Tav appears thousands of times throughout the Torah, and there are several key passages where the placement of Aleph-Tav carries profound meaning—especially when looking at prophecy about Yeshua. Look at the items that begin with the letter alef; can you read the names aloud? Run your finger underneath the letters and remember that Hebrew is read from right to left.

HEBREW LETTER OF THE MONTH OF CHESHVAN

Show them the picture. Trace the letter with your finger and say "alef" then take their index finger and gently trace over the letter, repeat.

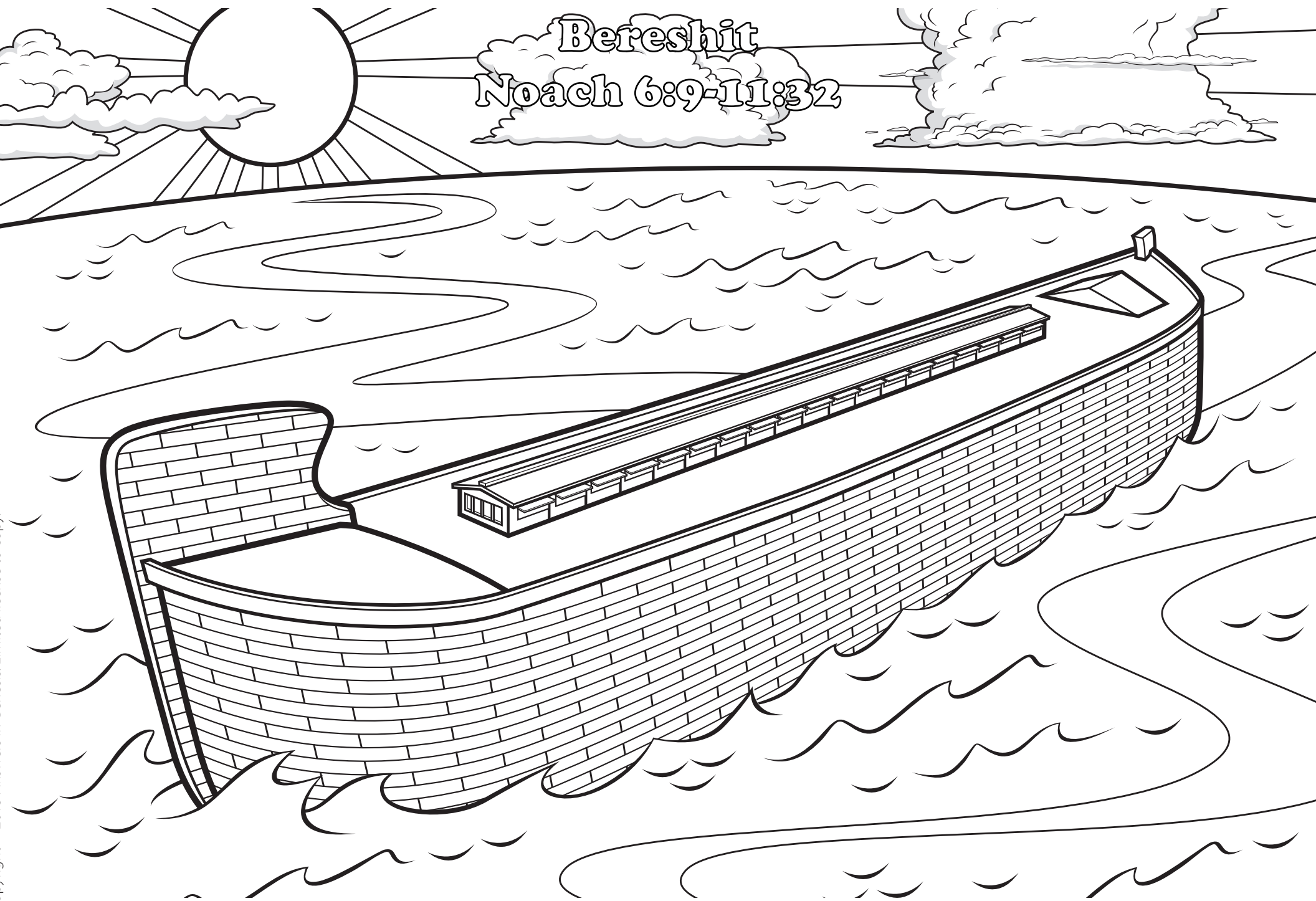
