HEBREW LETTER OF THE MONTH OF AV

This month’s letter of the alef-bet is Lamed. It is the fifteenth letter of the alef-bet and the tallest letter of the alef-bet. Say: lah-MeHD! Lamed makes same sound as English letter “L”. Which is made by pushing the tip of your tongue up against where your top teeth meet the roof of your mouth. Look at the wonderful things that begin with the letter lamed. The name comes from the same root as lamad-Ivrit for teach or learn. There are many pictures below that begin with the letter yod; can you read the names aloud? Place your finger underneath the letters and remember that Hebrew is read from right to left.

Show them the picture. Trace the letter with your finger and say "lamed" then take their index finger and gently trace over the letter, repeat.

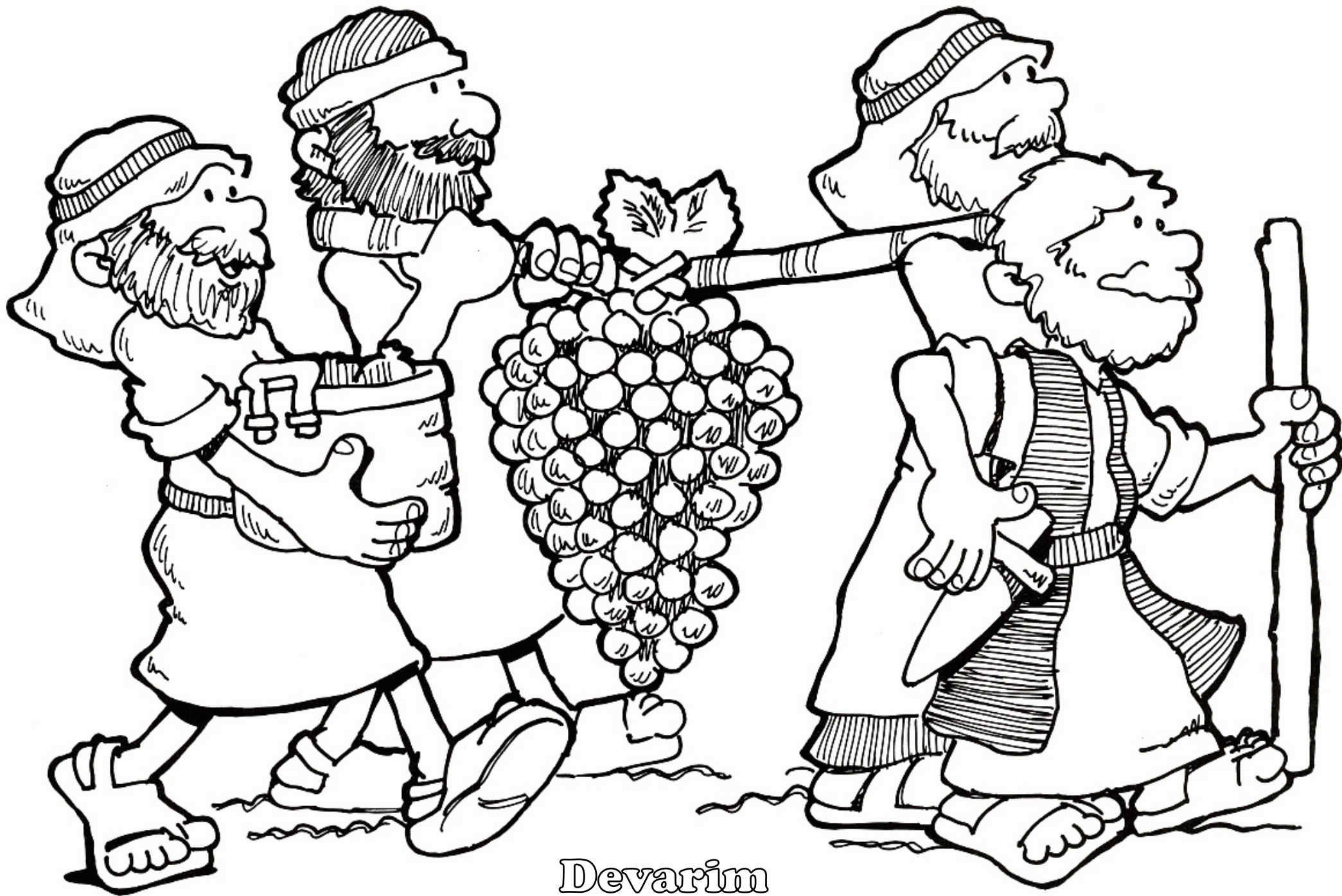
