HEBREW LETTER OF THE MONTH OF ADAR I

Mem: is a Hebrew letter that makes a sound similar to our English letter 'm'. The Mem sound is made by closing our lips and humming like we smell something yummy. It is the first letter of the parsha Mishpatim “ordinances” and the first letter of the word mishkahn “the tabernacle”. Look at all the fun pictures below each of them begin with the letter mem. Can you read the names aloud? Place your finger underneath the letters and remember that Hebrew is read from right to left.

Show them the picture. Trace the letter with your finger and say “mem” then take their index finger and gently trace over the letter, repeat.


