## HEBREW LETTER OF THE MONTH OF TEVET

This month's letter of the alef-bet is Gimmel. It is the third letter of the alef-bet. Say: "gimmel". Gimmel makes the sound that is similar to the English letter "G" as it is pronounced in girl, but not as it sounds in gem. There is no sound in Ivrit (Hebrew) that makes the 'j' sound. Which is why we say Yosef, and not Joseph. It is written in Talmud that the gimmel is a rich man chasing after a poor man –the dalet 4th letter (dalut means poor) in order to give to him tzedakah (charity). The gimmel indeed resembles someone running, or else the front part of a camel. Camel in Ivrit starts with the gimmel. Trace the gimmel below, and then look at the items that begin with the letter Bet and Vet below; can you read the names aloud? Run your finger underneath the letters and remember that Hebrew is read from right to left.
