HEBREW LETTER OF THE MONTH OF KISLEV

This month's letter of the alef-bet is Bet/Vet. It is the second letter of the alef-bet. Say: "Bet". Say: "Vet". Bet has a dagesh. The dagesh is a very special dot that changes the sound of the VET into a BET. The vet does not have a dagesh. The vet makes the sound we equate with the letter "V" in English. The bet makes the same sound as the letter "B". This letter is a lot of fun and helps us understand how the dagesh works in Ivrit (Hebrew). Then look at the items that begin with the letter Bet and Vet below; can you read the names aloud? Run your finger underneath the letters and remember that Hebrew is read from right to left.
