**Rabbi's Drash:**

When Moshe came back down mount Sinai, his face glowed and shone Brightly - so bright the Israelites couldn't look at him!

29 Now it happened, when Moses came down from Mount Sinai with the two tablets of the Testimony in his hand when he came down from the mountain, that Moses did not know that the skin of his face was radiant, because God had spoken with him.

That's because he was in the Presence of Ad-nai (for 40 days too!). In 2 Corinthians 3, Rav Sha'ul is giving a drash on This exact event. In verse 13, it says that we (followers of Messiah Yeshua) are not like Moses because we don't have to cover our faces with a veil to hide the brightness of Ad-nai's presence. Rather, we are to shine this light wherever we go! We are to reflect the light of Yeshua with each day we live. With every decision that we make we either choose to reflect HIS light, or we choose not too.
