IDENTITY: HEARER OF G-D'S WORD 5 MINUTES	Read Portions: Bereshit 6:9-11:32 (6:9-11:32) Yesha'yahu 54:1-55:5 (54:1-55:5) Mattiyahu 24:36-44 (24:36-44) Learn our memory verse for the year 5786.>>	Memory Verse: Yeshayahu 41:10 ¹⁰ Fear not, for I am with you, be not dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you. Surely I will help you. I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.
IDENTITY: BELIEVER OF G-D'S WORD 5 MINUTES	Ask: What were Noach's reasons for <u>NOT</u> building the ark? (how many reasons do you have for not reading Torah, not obeying parents, not being good?)	Discuss: What was the reason all of the rest of the people the ark was built to hold did not get on board? (Why do you play on your tablet during worship, draw during service, not pay attention in class?)

IDENTITY: FOLLOWER OF G-D'S WORD 5 MINUTES	Ask: What is G-D's promise to those who choose to love HIM?	Discuss: Who is the nation? (all speculation). How many ways were there onto the ark?
IDENTITY: DOER OF G-D'S WORD 5 MINUTES	Who we are is largely dependent upon what we do; we heed the warning and follow G-D not the culture.	Ask: Is there warning before the destruction? What does it look like?
GAME/ACTIVITY	Discussion	<<-Why don't we just behave??
HOMEWORK 3 MINUTES	Our letter of the month of Teitzei is resh. Look around shul for something that begins with the resh sound; "Shavua tov, until next week!"	Close with prayer: say out loud what you are grateful for and things you need prayer for today.

The first goal is to approach all scripture with humility and prayer.

Have you ever tried to do everything right? To make all the right choices? To do everything exactly how you should do it? Yet no matter how hard you tried you couldn't do everything right? You are not alone. In this week's Parsha, we learn that Noah and for that matter every person ever has the same problems. In Genesis 6:9 we read.

9These are the genealogies of Noah. Noah was a righteous man. He was blameless among his generation. Noah continually walked with God.

When you read this verse, you might think that it is saying Noah didn't ever do anything wrong. But that is not true. What it is saying is because Noah walked we Ad-nai continually Ad-nai considered Noah righteous and blameless. It was walking with Ad-nai that made Noah righteous, and it is walking with Ad-nai that makes us righteous today.
