

Standing on the Promises of G-D

Raise your hand if you have ever been promised something that you were really excited about, and then you never got it.

Maybe the someone who promised forgot all about it.

Maybe something happened and they couldn't keep their promise.

Maybe they broke their promise because they were angry with you, or for some other reason, but I bet you it made you feel pretty bad. Maybe you felt unappreciated, or even unimportant, or like the person who made the promise did not care about you. Maybe they did, maybe they did not, but I have some really great news for you! G-D never has, and never will break a promise to you. Everything you read in HIS word is true, and HE says it about HIMSELF:



He says in His word that His promises are true for everyone. Every person is eligible, not one person is excluded. Everyone who has ever lived, or will ever be alive, has the opportunity to accept and stand on the promises of G-D.

READ Devarim 29:9-14.

Notice that HE says all. Water-carriers and woodcutters, men and women, slaves and free, even those who are not present but who will ultimately join G-D and HIS Kingdom.

Rav Shaul says in his letter to Timothy:

¹³if we are faithless, He remains faithful, for He cannot deny Himself.

~2 Timothy 2:13

All that is promised in the word of G-D, all that HE has said will be. If we read it in HIS word, we will never be disappointed by Him. We can trust that He will be faithful in all things, for HE who promised is faithful.
