OUR CORPORATE COVENANT BEFORE GOD

We, the members and attendees of Life Touch Community Church in Plainfield, Illinois, having gathered on this 24th day of January in the year 2026, do solemnly enter into covenant with Almighty God and with one another.

Having heard the vision that God has given for this church, and having been stirred by the Holy Spirit to participate in what He is doing, we now declare and commit ourselves to the following:

I. OUR COVENANT WITH GOD

We covenant to:

SEEK HIS PRESENCE DAILY

We commit to prioritizing intimate relationship with God through daily prayer, Bible reading, and worship. We will position ourselves by the rivers of His presence, drawing life and strength from Him alone.

SUBMIT TO HIS PRUNING

We will see visible transformation in the character and conduct of every member, with growth in the fruit of the Spirit evident to all.
