THE VISION FOR 2026

2026 is our year of **SPIRITUAL FRUITFULNESS**. God has given us a clear blueprint for growth, multiplication, and kingdom impact. This is not a vision born from human ambition, but a divine mandate received through prayer and confirmed by the Holy Spirit.

THEME: FRUITFUL BY DESIGN

God is intentional. Fruitfulness doesn't happen by accident—it happens by design. Just as an architect creates a detailed blueprint before construction begins, God has drawn a precise blueprint for Life Touch Community Church in 2026. Our assignment is to execute this blueprint with excellence and faith.

THE 4-PILLAR STRATEGY

Our growth strategy is built on four foundational pillars. Like a building, if any pillar is weak, the structure is unstable. But when all four pillars are strong, we can build high and build strong.

PILLAR 1: EVERY MEMBER A MINISTER

In a church of 20-50 members, every person must be active in ministry. There are no spectators—only participants. Every member will discover their spiritual gifts, receive training, and serve in at least one ministry area.

Goal: 100% member mobilization by April 2026

PILLAR 2: RADICAL HOSPITALITY

First impressions are lasting impressions. Every guest must feel welcomed, valued, and invited to return. We will create an exceptional guest experience from parking lot to farewell, with follow-up within 24 hours.

Goal: Every guest greeted within 30 seconds, 100% follow-up achieved

PILLAR 3: STRATEGIC EVANGELISM

Church growth happens through personal relationships and authentic evangelism. Every member will identify their "Top 5" people to reach, complete evangelism training, and actively share their faith.

Goal: 40+ salvations through personal evangelism in 2026

PILLAR 4: INTENSIVE DISCIPLESHIP

Evangelism without discipleship creates converts, not disciples. Every new believer will enter our 8-week newcomer pathway, connecting them to small groups, ministry, and membership.

Goal: 90% completion rate of discipleship pathway

- Personal evangelism training (February-March)
- Spiritual gifts workshops
- Ministry-specific training

3. ACTIVE EVANGELISM & INVITATIONS

- Pray for lost souls daily ("Top 5" list)
- Share your faith naturally
- Invite people to church weekly
- Bring guests to special events

4. FINANCIAL STEWARDSHIP

- Faithful tithing (10% of income)
- Generous offerings above the tithe
- Support vision projects
- Faith-promise giving

5. PRAYER & FASTING COMMITMENT

- Daily personal prayer (30 minutes minimum)
- Corporate prayer meetings
- Three fasting seasons: 21-Day (Jan 26-Feb 15), 14-Day Summer (Aug 10-23), 7-Day Thanksgiving (Nov 16-22)

- Mark your calendar for the entire year

PARTICIPATION:

- Come prepared (read assigned materials if applicable)
- Engage in discussions (no silent spectators)
- Share your life authentically
- Pray for group members throughout the month/week
- Support one another in practical ways

CONFIDENTIALITY:

- What's shared in the group stays in the group
- Honor vulnerability with discretion
- Build a safe space for authenticity
- Respect privacy and personal boundaries

GROWTH & MULTIPLICATION:

- Small groups are designed to grow and multiply
 - Youth Group may split into age-specific groups as it grows
 - Men's and Women's groups may add additional monthly meetings
 - Be willing to help birth new groups when needed
 - Senior members may be asked to lead new groups

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

A: Life happens! Just notify your leader. Missing occasionally is okay, but consistent attendance is important for building relationships.

Q: Do I need to bring anything?

A: Just yourself and an open heart! Bible and notebook are helpful but not required. Refreshments are typically provided.

Q: Is childcare provided?

A: Youth Group (Mondays) - No, this is for ages 13-30

Women's Group (Saturdays) - Currently no, but we can arrange
if multiple women have this need

Men's Group (Saturdays) - No, but bring your teen sons if
appropriate

Q: What if I miss the first meeting?

A: You can join at any time! Contact the leader, and they'll get you caught up. It's never too late to plug in.

Q: Can I attend more than one group?

A: If your schedule allows, yes! Some may attend Youth Group weekly and Women's/Men's Group monthly.

Q: What curriculum will we use?

A: Groups will primarily follow our monthly sermon themes, ensuring alignment with the church's vision. Some groups may supplement with additional materials.

Q: How long do the groups last?

A: We're committing to run these groups through December 2026, with plans to continue and multiply in 2027 and beyond.

Q: What if I want to lead a group?

A: Praise God! Talk to Pastor Augustine about leadership training. We're always looking for qualified leaders to help us multiply groups.
