A WORD FROM PASTOR AUGUSTINE

Beloved Life Touch Family,

Grace and peace to you in the mighty name of our Lord Jesus Christ!

As we stand at the threshold of 2026, I am filled with holy anticipation for what God is about to do in and through Life Touch Community Church - Plainfield. The season from now through March 1, 2027 is not just another timeframe - this is a divine appointment, a kairos moment when heaven's purposes align with our obedient response.

For over a decade, Gloria and I have served in global ministry, and we have witnessed God's faithfulness in every season. We have seen Him take small beginnings and multiply them beyond imagination. We have watched Him transform lives, build churches, and advance His Kingdom in impossible situations. And now, He has given us a clear, compelling vision for Life Touch Ministries in 2026: ***Fruitful by Design***.

Who We Are

Life Touch Community Church - Plainfield is a Word-centered, Spirit-led, non-denominational church based in Plainfield, Illinois. Operating under Life Touch Ministries NFP, we are committed to touching lives and transforming destinies through the power of the Gospel. Our foundation is biblical truth, our passion is evangelism, and our mission is making disciples who make disciples.

Our Mission

Love God, Love People, and Make Disciples of Jesus Christ

We exist to introduce people to Jesus Christ, equip them to grow in spiritual maturity, and mobilize them to impact their world for God's Kingdom. We are committed to biblical teaching, authentic worship, fervent prayer, compassionate service, and relentless evangelism.

The 2026 Vision: Fruitful by Design

From now through March 1, 2027, Life Touch Community Church - Plainfield will grow from 17 members to 50+ members through intentional, Spirit-empowered evangelism and discipleship. Every member will be equipped, mobilized, and actively bearing fruit in three dimensions:

- **Fruit of the Spirit:** Demonstrating Christ-like character (Galatians 5:22-23)
- **Fruit of Evangelism:** Winning souls to Christ (Romans 1:13)
- **Fruit of Discipleship:** Maturing believers into disciple-makers (Colossians 1:10)

This is not random growth - it is **fruitful by design**. Just as a gardener carefully tends a vineyard, God has given us a strategic blueprint to cultivate a thriving, multiplying church that glorifies Him and extends His Kingdom in Plainfield and beyond.

OUR 4-PILLAR STRATEGY

To achieve our vision of growing from 17 to 50+ members by March 1, 2027, we are implementing a strategic framework built on four foundational pillars. These pillars work together to create a sustainable culture of fruitfulness and multiplication.

PILLAR 1: EVERY MEMBER A MINISTER

We reject the clergy-laity divide. Every believer is called to ministry. Every member has been gifted by the Holy Spirit for service. Every person has a role to play in building God's Kingdom. We are not building a church of spectators but a movement of ministers.

What This Means:

- Every member completes a spiritual gifts assessment and is deployed accordingly
- Everyone serves in at least one ministry area (worship, hospitality, children, prayer, outreach, etc.)
- Ministry leaders are raised up from within our congregation
- We equip the saints for the work of ministry (Ephesians 4:11-12)
- No one sits idle - everyone contributes to the mission

PILLAR 2: RADICAL HOSPITALITY

First-time guests should feel the love of Christ the moment they step onto our property. Radical hospitality means we go above and beyond to welcome, serve, and honor every person who walks through our doors. We create an environment where people feel valued, accepted, and eager to return.

What This Means:

- Trained greeters who warmly welcome every person by name
- Clean, inviting facilities that honor our guests
- Excellence in children's ministry so parents can worship without worry
- Follow-up within 24 hours of a first visit (text, email, phone call)
- Connection partners assigned to help new people integrate
- Fellowship meals and events that build authentic community

PILLAR 3: STRATEGIC EVANGELISM

Evangelism is not optional - it's the heartbeat of the church. We are intentional, strategic, and relentless in reaching the lost. Through the 1-1-1 Multiplication Principle, we equip every member to be an effective soul-winner. We combine personal evangelism with large-scale community outreach events to maximize our Kingdom impact.

What This Means:

- Every member trained in personal evangelism and gospel presentation
- Monthly evangelism training workshops
- Quarterly outreach events targeting the Plainfield community

- Social media campaigns amplifying our gospel witness
- Prayer walking neighborhoods and praying for divine appointments
- Servant evangelism - meeting practical needs while sharing Jesus
- Invitational culture - everyone invites someone weekly

PILLAR 4: INTENSIVE DISCIPLESHIP

Making converts is good; making disciples is essential. We don't just get people saved - we grow them up in Christ. Through small groups, one-on-one mentoring, and systematic biblical teaching, we nurture believers into mature, fruitful followers of Jesus who can reproduce themselves in others.

What This Means:

- New believer classes immediately following salvation
- Small groups focused on biblical study, prayer, and accountability
- One-on-one discipleship relationships (mature believers mentoring newer ones)
- Systematic theology classes covering core doctrines
- Leadership development pipeline for emerging leaders
- Baptism class and public testimony opportunities
- 52-week sermon series on spiritual fruitfulness reinforcing discipleship

THE COMMITMENT REQUIRED

Vision is free, but execution costs something. To see this blueprint fulfilled, every member must commit to five essential disciplines:

1. FAITHFULNESS IN ATTENDANCE

- Consistent Sunday worship (unless sick/traveling)
- Wednesday prayer meetings
- Small group participation
- Special events and trainings

Hebrews 10:25 commands us not to forsake the assembling of ourselves together. Your presence matters. Your participation encourages others. Your absence is felt. Consistency builds momentum, and momentum creates breakthroughs.

2. PARTICIPATION IN TRAINING

- Monthly equipping sessions
- Personal evangelism training (February-March)
- Spiritual gifts workshops
- Ministry-specific training

You cannot give what you don't have. Training equips you to be effective in ministry and evangelism. Attending these sessions is not optional - it is essential. We will provide the tools, but you must show up to receive them.

3. ACTIVE EVANGELISM & INVITATIONS

- Pray for lost souls daily ("Top 5" list)
- Share your faith naturally
- Invite people to church weekly
- Bring guests to special events

The 1-1-1 Multiplication Principle only works if you work it. You must be intentional about reaching one person per quarter. Identify them. Pray for them. Build relationship with them. Share the gospel with them. Invite them. This is your assignment from God.

4. FINANCIAL STEWARDSHIP

- Faithful tithing (10% of income)
- Generous offerings above the tithe
- Support vision projects
- Faith-promise giving

Vision requires resources. Outreach events cost money. Training materials cost money. Ministering to people costs money. Malachi 3:10 promises that God will open the windows of heaven and pour out blessings when we honor Him with our tithes and offerings. Give faithfully. Give generously. Watch God multiply your seed.

5. PRAYER & FASTING COMMITMENT

- Daily personal prayer (30 minutes minimum)
- Corporate prayer meetings

Nothing of eternal significance happens without prayer. If we want to see God move in power, we must be a praying church. Corporate fasting breaks demonic strongholds, releases spiritual breakthroughs, and positions us for harvest. Commit to these disciplines. Your prayers and fasting will fuel the 2026 vision.

Are you ready to commit?

This vision will cost you something - your time, your energy, your resources, your comfort. But what it produces is priceless - transformed lives, eternal souls, Kingdom advancement, and the joy of partnering with God in His harvest. The question is not "Can we do this?" The question is "Will we do this?"

2026 FASTING SEASONS

Throughout 2026, we will engage in three strategic corporate fasts designed to position us for breakthrough, harvest, and victory. These are not optional spiritual exercises - they are essential weapons in our arsenal for church growth and Kingdom advancement.

MONTHLY PRAYER FOCUS

Consistent, fervent prayer is the foundation of everything we do. These regular prayer gatherings keep us connected to God's heart, aligned with His will, and empowered by His Spirit.

Weekly: Wednesday Prayer Service (7:00-8:30 PM)

Every Wednesday evening, we gather corporately to seek God's face, intercede for the lost, pray for church growth, and contend for breakthrough. This is the engine room of our church - the place where vision is fueled and spiritual battles are won.

Monthly: First Friday All-Night Prayer (10 PM - 6 AM)

On the first Friday of each month, we engage in extended prayer through the night. This is a time of deep intercession, spiritual warfare, prophetic declaration, and seeking God's direction for the church.

Monthly: Last Saturday Strategic Prayer (9 AM - 12 PM)

On the last Saturday of each month, we gather for strategic prayer focused specifically on church growth, evangelism, and the 1-1-1 Multiplication Principle. We pray by name for those we are reaching, intercede for upcoming outreach events, and seek divine strategies for harvest.

Remember:

"Nothing of eternal significance happens without prayer. If we are going to see 50 members by March 1, 2027, we must be a praying church. Your participation in these corporate prayer gatherings is not optional - it is essential."

THE BIBLICAL FOUNDATION

The Vine and the Branches (John 15:1-8)

Our vision for 2026 is anchored in Jesus' teaching on spiritual fruitfulness. In John 15, Jesus uses the powerful metaphor of a vineyard to illustrate our relationship with Him and our purpose in His Kingdom.

Jesus is the True Vine:

He is the source of all life, nourishment, and fruitfulness. Without connection to Him, we can produce nothing of eternal value. Every ounce of spiritual vitality flows from our union with Christ.

We are the Branches:

As branches connected to Jesus, we are designed to bear fruit. This is not optional - it is our purpose. Fruitfulness is the natural result of abiding in Christ. The branch that remains connected to the vine will inevitably produce abundant fruit.

The Father is the Gardener:

God the Father lovingly tends His vineyard. He cuts off dead branches and prunes fruitful branches so they will be even more fruitful (John 15:2). Pruning is not punishment - it is preparation for greater productivity. The challenges we face, the discipline we experience, and the refinement God brings are all part of His loving care to maximize our fruitfulness.

The Key: Abiding in Christ (John 15:5)

"If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing." Fruitfulness is not about human effort, programs, or strategies. It is about abiding - maintaining intimate, dependent, moment-by-moment connection with Jesus. When we abide, fruit is inevitable. When we disconnect, fruitlessness is guaranteed.

The Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20)

Jesus did not give us the Great Suggestion - He gave us the Great Commission. "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you." This command is not for pastors alone. It is for every believer. We are all called to go, make disciples, baptize, and teach.

Our 2026 vision is simply obedience to the Great Commission. We are going into our community - Plainfield, Joliet, Crest Hill, Romeoville - and making disciples. We are baptizing new believers. We are teaching them to obey Jesus. And as they mature, they will do the same for others. This is multiplication. This is Kingdom advancement. This is fruitfulness by design.

Multiplication in Action (2 Timothy 2:2)

Paul instructed Timothy, "The things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable people who will also be qualified to teach others." Notice the four generations in this verse: Paul → Timothy → Reliable People → Others. This is exponential multiplication.

Our 1-1-1 Multiplication Principle is built on this biblical model. We are not just making converts; we are making disciple-makers who make disciple-makers. Every person we reach is trained to reach others. Every believer is equipped to equip others. This is how small churches become large churches. This is how 17 becomes 50, and 50 becomes 150, and 150 becomes 500.

THE 1-1-1 MULTIPLICATION PRINCIPLE

What Is It?

The 1-1-1 Principle is simple: **Every member reaches ONE person per QUARTER through ONE intentional relationship.**

This is not about becoming a super-evangelist. It is about being faithful with what God has already given you - your relationships, your testimony, your authenticity, and your love for people. One person. One quarter. That's it.

Why Does It Work?

- **It's Biblical:** Jesus modeled relational disciple-making. He invested deeply in a few who then reached many.
- **It's Sustainable:** Everyone can reach one person in three months. It's achievable, not overwhelming.
- **It's Exponential:** When everyone participates, growth multiplies quickly.
- **It's Relational:** People are won through genuine friendship, not cold evangelism tactics.
- **It's Spirit-Led:** God sovereignly places people in our paths. We simply respond with obedience.

How Do I Do It?

Step 1: PRAY

Ask God to show you one person in your sphere of influence who needs Jesus. This could be a family member, friend, coworker, neighbor, or acquaintance. Pray for them daily by name. Pray for divine appointments, open doors, and a soft heart.

Step 2: BUILD

Develop an authentic friendship. Show genuine care. Serve them. Listen to them. Be Jesus to them in practical ways. Let them see Christ's love in action through your life. Don't manipulate - demonstrate.

Step 3: SHARE

When the Holy Spirit opens the door, share your testimony and the Gospel. You don't need to be a preacher. Just tell your story - what your life was like before Christ, how you met Him, and how He's changed you. Then explain the simple Gospel: Jesus died for our sins, rose from the dead, and offers forgiveness and new life to all who believe.

Step 4: INVITE

Invite them to church, small group, or a special event. Make it easy for them to say yes. Offer to pick them up. Sit with them. Introduce them to others. Help them feel welcomed and valued.

Step 5: DISCIPLE

Once they give their life to Christ, walk with them in their new faith. Help them get baptized. Connect them to a small group. Answer their questions. Model what it means to follow Jesus. And then - this is key - train them to reach someone else. The cycle continues.

Your Role in the Vision

You are not a spectator in God's harvest - you are a laborer (Matthew 9:37-38). Your participation is essential. If everyone commits to reaching one person per quarter, we will easily exceed our goal of 50 members by March 1, 2027. But if people opt out, we will fall short.

This is your moment. This is your mission. You were created for this. The people God has placed in your life need Jesus, and you are the perfect person to introduce them. Will you say yes?

THE GROWTH ROADMAP: QUARTER BY QUARTER

Our journey from 17 to 50+ members is intentional and strategic. Each quarter has a specific focus that builds on the previous one, creating sustainable momentum through March 1, 2027.

Q1: FOUNDATION PHASE (March - May 2026)

Goal: 17 → 21 Members

Quarter 1 is all about laying a strong spiritual foundation. Before we can effectively reach others, we must be deeply rooted in Christ. This quarter focuses on personal spiritual formation, testimony development, and evangelism preparation.

Key Activities:

- 21-Day Fast (January 26 - February 15, 2026): Corporate prayer and fasting for spiritual breakthrough and church growth
- The Gathering 2026 (February 15, 2026): Vision-casting service that launches the year with faith and commitment
- Personal testimony training: Every member develops and practices their 3-minute testimony
- Prayer list development: Everyone identifies 3-5 people to pray for and reach
- Introduction to relational evangelism principles
- Community prayer walk in Plainfield neighborhoods
- Easter Outreach preparation begins (late March)

Training Focus:

- Abiding in Christ (John 15)
- Fruit of the Spirit cultivation (Galatians 5:22-23)
- Personal spiritual disciplines (prayer, Bible reading, fasting)
- Living as salt and light (Matthew 5:13-16)

Q2: MULTIPLICATION PHASE (June - August 2026)

Goal: 21 → 29 Members

With a strong foundation in place, Quarter 2 shifts into active evangelism mode. Members are equipped with gospel presentation skills and deployed into their communities with confidence and boldness.

Key Activities:

- Easter Sunday Outreach (early April): Major invite campaign + special service designed for seekers

- Community Block Party (May): Plainfield neighborhood event with food, games, bounce houses, and gospel presentations
- Father's Day Celebration (June): Men's outreach breakfast + family-focused service
- Small group cookouts: Members host informal gatherings with unsaved friends
- Social media evangelism campaign
- Personal evangelism efforts intensify - members actively sharing gospel

Training Focus:

- Gospel presentation methods (Romans Road, Bridge Illustration)
- Handling objections to Christianity
- Invitational evangelism strategies
- Digital evangelism and social media outreach
- Boldness and overcoming fear of rejection

Q3: EXPANSION PHASE (September - November 2026)

Goal: 29 → 40 Members

Momentum is building. New believers are being assimilated. Now it's time to expand our reach through strategic community engagement and service initiatives. We demonstrate Christ's love through compassionate action while continuing to share the gospel.

Key Activities:

- Back-to-School Community Carnival (late July/early August): Backpack giveaway, school supplies, games, and gospel
- Serve Plainfield Month (August): Weekly service projects - food pantry, park cleanup, nursing home visits, single-parent assistance
- Labor Day Outreach Picnic (September): Large community gathering with testimonies and gospel invitation
- Launch 3 small groups led by trained members
- Spiritual gifts discovery workshops

Training Focus:

- Discipleship fundamentals - Nurturing new believers
- Small group leadership development
- Community service and compassion ministry
- Multiplication mindset - Training others to train
- Event evangelism and large-scale outreach

Q4: HARVEST PHASE (October - March 1, 2027)

Goal: 40 → 50+ Members

The final quarter is about bringing in the harvest and ensuring new members are fully integrated. This is also when we begin developing emerging leaders and casting vision for 2027 to sustain momentum beyond this year.

Key Activities:

- Fall Harvest Festival (October): Large family-friendly event targeting unchurched families
- Thanksgiving Food Drive & Distribution (November): Serve 100+ families in Plainfield
- Christmas Extravaganza (December 2026): Multiple Christmas services, caroling, gift distribution, testimonies
- New Year's Eve Crossover Service: Celebratory service inviting community
- Victory Celebration (March 1, 2027): Testify of God's faithfulness and celebrate reaching 50+ members
- Leadership development intensive for emerging leaders

Training Focus:

- New member integration and assimilation
- Leadership development and team building
- Stewardship and generosity training
- Vision for 2027 - Sustaining momentum
- Celebration of wins and strategic planning

Step 1: Sign Your Covenant Declaration

In your vision packet, you'll find a 2026 Covenant Declaration card. This is your personal commitment to God and to Life Touch Community Church - Plainfield that you will be fruitful by design in 2026. Read it prayerfully, then sign it and return it to the collection box today.

Step 2: Complete Your Ministry Interest Form

Every member serves. Fill out the Ministry Interest Form indicating where God is calling you to serve. Don't overthink it - just ask the Holy Spirit to guide you. Return this form today so we can connect you with your ministry team.

Step 3: Identify Your "One"

This week, ask God to show you one person to reach this quarter. Write their name down. Start praying for them daily. Look for opportunities to build relationship and demonstrate Christ's love.

Step 4: Attend Monthly Training

Mark your calendar for the first Saturday of every month. These 90-minute training workshops will equip you with practical skills for evangelism, discipleship, and ministry. Your attendance is crucial.

Step 5: Join a Small Group

Growth happens in community. If you're not already in a small group, join one. This is where you'll receive encouragement, accountability, and support as you pursue fruitfulness.

Step 6: Commit to Wednesday Prayer

Our Wednesday Evening Prayer & Worship Service is the engine room of this vision. We will pray for the lost, intercede for church growth, and seek God's power and guidance. Make this a non-negotiable weekly commitment.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: What if I'm not good at evangelism?

A: You don't have to be "good" at evangelism - you just have to be obedient. We will train you. We will equip you. We will support you. And most importantly, the Holy Spirit will empower you. Your job is to be faithful; God's job is to bring the results. Remember, people are more likely to be won through authentic relationships than slick presentations.

Q: What if I don't reach someone this quarter?

A: The goal is faithfulness, not flawless performance. If you prayed, built relationships, shared your testimony, and invited people, you've been faithful - even if no one made a decision yet. Seeds take time to grow. Keep praying, keep planting, keep trusting God for the harvest. And remember, you have a new quarter starting soon!

Q: How much time will this require?

A: The 1-1-1 principle is designed to fit naturally into your existing life. You're not starting a new program - you're being intentional with relationships you already have. Monthly training is 90 minutes. Wednesday prayer is an hour. Beyond that, it's just living your life with purpose. This is sustainable, not overwhelming.

Q: What if I'm a new believer?

A: Perfect! New believers are often the most effective evangelists because their excitement is contagious and they still have lots of unsaved friends. You don't need to know everything - just share what Jesus has done for you. Your testimony is powerful. We'll walk with you every step of the way.

Q: Can I serve in multiple ministry areas?

A: Yes, as long as you don't burn out! We want you serving joyfully, not exhausted. Start with one primary area and see how it goes. If you have capacity for more, let us know. The key is sustainable faithfulness.

Q: What about my family/work/other commitments?

A: Your family and work are ministry too! You don't need to choose between them and church. In fact, your family members and coworkers are often the best people to reach. Live out your faith authentically where you are, and let God multiply your impact.

Q: What happens after we reach 50 members?

A: We keep going! Reaching 50 is a milestone, not a finish line. We'll celebrate, give God glory, and then set our sights on 100, 150, 200... The harvest is plentiful. Our mission doesn't stop until Jesus returns.
